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

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Site Inspection





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Above Ground Storage Tanks (AST)

- Not required to have spill containment receptacle.
 - If it is installed, it must comply with regulations for underground storage tanks




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Violations (2010-2015)

646 Violations


- Section 301 – Spill Containment violations
 - 290 violations - Holes, cracks, foreign material
- Section 302 – Fill Pipe violations
 - 90 violations - Fill pipe distance from the bottom
 - 44 violations – Fill pipe cap – damaged or gasket missing
- Section 502 - Recordkeeping
 - 144 violations – Not readily available, missing inspections, fuel throughput

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Violations



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On-Site Inspection

- Tank inspection
 - Clean spill containment receptacles
 - Cap Gaskets installed
 - Fill pipe measures less than 6" from the bottom
 - Fill pipe assembly is tight and does not turn
 - Only one delivery pipe (if more than one lock all others)

CLEAN AIR MAKE MORE **Dust Generating Operations** Section 9

• Opacity
- Emissions cannot exceed 20%
- Dust cannot go beyond the property line (vehicle traffic, overseeding, landscaping, weed abatement).
• Disturbed Surface Areas – stability requirement
- Crust
- Vegetation

CLEAN AIR MAKE MORE **P-25 Leaf Blower Ordinance**

• Purpose
- To prohibit the use of leaf blowers for blowing of landscape debris into public roadways and operating leaf blowers on surfaces that have not been stabilized.
• Applicability
- This ordinance applies to individual private users, landscaping companies, and public employees within sections of Area A.

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CLEAN AIR MAKE MORE **P-25 Leaf Blower Ordinance**

• Restrictions
- Blowing of landscape debris into public roadways.
- Operating leaf blowers on surfaces that have not been stabilized.
• Landscape debris includes but is not limited to:
- Grass clippings, leaves, branches, soil, and rock
• Stabilized surface
- Asphaltic concrete, cement concrete, gravel, grass or other continuous vegetative cover

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Overseeding

- Generally overseeding projects do not require a dust permit on their own; however, the dust emissions generated during these projects are still regulated.
- Use dust control measures when dust is visible, ex. water application, street sweeping.
- Visible emissions cannot travel beyond the property line.



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Overseeding Tips

- Avoid scalping on windy days
- Don't over dry the area
- Apply water to moisten the area prior to scalping
- Keep dust collection screens and filters in good working order.
- Moisten piles before transporting.
