Cactus and Pine "Hack-Attack" Golf League 2013 Rules & Regulations

Purpose:

The summer golf league was established to promote the game within our association. The objective is to build some camaraderie among peers, to share knowledge about the art of greenskeeping, and to enjoy the social element that occurs naturally during a round of golf.

Regulations:

- 1. Golf event participants will be established in a joint effort between the hosting property and the league officials.
 - The host will establish a maximum number of players prior to each event.
 - League hosting properties will have the first right of entry for submitting player registrations (2 players/ property).
 - Cactus and pine members will compose the field on a first come, first serve basis.
 - Other players can be invited only as a guest of a C & P member if space is available and approved by the league officials and host.
- 2. All player transactions will be confirmed only via email the week prior to each event.
 - A list of player email contacts will be established before the season.
 - Emails sent out further than a week in advance will not be confirmed.
 - Players will be responsible for contacting the host property representative and the league officials with one email.
 - Players can request being paired with other players, but said pairings will not be guaranteed.
 - Players that RSVP and don't show without notice will pay double fees for their next event.
 - The goal is to improve communication and coordination with email documentation.
 - No walk-ons will be allowed to play.
- 3. The host will determine the golf format and associated fees of the scheduled event.
 - The entry fee for the skins game is optional.
 - The main objective for every event is to finish within 4 hours and slow play will not be tolerated.
 - Local rules can be established to promote fair and fast play. In General, the desert rule will be in effect for most events (nearest turf relief w/ 2 stroke penalty).
- 4. The hosting facility will define F & B / Golf operations accommodations and responsibilities.
 - Property outlets can offer their services as a source of revenue. Drink specials are welcome and tipping is highly recommended.
 - The league policy is to be as streamlined as possible and not interfere with other club activities.
 - The neighborhood "Cantina" is always a great option to conclude the event with scoring and awards.
- 5. All Cactus and Pine members are welcomed without discrimination of their classification.
 - Individual vendor sponsorships and donations are not allowed.
 - On occasion there will be a \$20 maximum donation for special events.
- 6. Scoring and Awards.
 - Participants must be present at the designated site to collect their prizes or cash award.
 - Unredeemed cash prizes will be donated to cover the expenses at the awards banquet.
 - No cash prizes will be carried over to the next scheduled event. If by chance that all skins are cancelled and all expenses are covered with significant (> \$40) money leftover, then a charitable donation will be made to the Cactus and Pine.
