### Dear Berkeley Hills Members,

As we enter into the Holiday season, I pray this message finds you and your family healthy and prospering in 2023. This has been an exciting year of growth and reinvention for Berkeley Hills, and it's been a true pleasure to witness our progress throughout the spring, summer and fall.

I'm writing to you today to request your assistance in saying "thank you" to our staff at Berkeley Hills who have once again dedicated a great portion of their time and energy to provide a high level of service for our membership this year. As in prior years, we have established a BHCC Employee Holiday Fund as a means for each member to be able to contribute to the staff as a whole.

Hard to believe that we've made it to December. Where did the year go? I hope you all had some great times on the golf course this season. I know I'm already looking forward to golf in 2024.

Now that we're almost to the beginning of winter (December 21st, for those of you who like to keep things official), I like to lead off these columns with a reminder about frost and covering greens. I included this info in last month's newsletter, so if you feel a sense of déjà vu as you're reading, don't worry, you're not seeing double.

Once the overnight low temperatures begin to drop into the 30's, I begin leaving messages on our course conditions phone line to update golfers on course status and inform you of when we have a delay in starting times for



frost or greens cover removal, as well as whether we will be on cart paths or 90 degrees. The Course Conditions Hotline number is 770-448-2008. Just dial it, then press 1 to hear current conditions.

I normally update the line a few minutes after sunrise, so remember to wait until we have some sunlight before you call in for the latest status report. The reason it's updated after sunrise is because we're not able to get a good assessment of frost conditions until we have enough light to be able to see all the greens complexes.



To the left is a picture of a golf green at another facility that golfers walked on while frost was on the green. You can see the damage caused to the turf from foot traffic in those conditions, damage that will take several months to heal. This is the reason we make sure to stay off the putting surfaces until frost is cleared. And remember, just because the practice green doesn't have frost on it, that doesn't mean that the frost has cleared off of other greens on the course that experience more early morning shade from the trees that surround them.

I also mentioned possible delays for removing greens covers. We evaluate covering greens when nighttime temperatures are forecast to drop into the 20's or lower. Now, there is some variation with that. Cur-

rently ground temperatures are still fairly warm, so if we have a night where the temperature is going to drop into the upper 20's, but the next day it'll be 50 and sunny for the high, there is no reason to cover. However, as the cold months stretch on and ground temperatures drop, the likelihood of having to cover for those colder nights increases. With our greens turf being less than two years old, we will continue to be conservative in choosing when to cover this winter.

In other maintenance news, we've been on leaf duty for about a month now, and will continue to fight the leaves on a daily basis until they've finished dropping for the year. Once that battle is over for another season, we'll begin our off-season plant and shrub pruning, and tackle some drainage projects to dry out approaches to some of the greens. We'll also be adding in some additional sprinkler heads to our irrigation system to permit watering areas of turf we haven't been able to irrigate in the past.

Finally, as I mentioned last month new range mats are on order. The manufacturer provided a shipping update at the end of November and told us to expect them sometime this month. We'll get those put out on the tee line for you to practice off of as soon as they arrive.

I hope everyone has a wonderful Christmas, and a happy New Year. See you out on the course!

We've arrived at the final month of the year and the golf season at Berkeley Hills is behind us for the most part. We had a lot of fun in November with the Tough Day and the Turkey Hunt...thanks to all of you who joined us for those tournaments and helped make them a success.

Even though we're near the finish line, there's still just a little more tournament golf to play this year, with the Senior Santa Claus 3-Man on the 7<sup>th</sup>,

Santa Claus Open on the 9<sup>th</sup>, and Ladies Mrs. Claus on the 13<sup>th</sup>. Be sure and sign up for these fun events and end your golf year with some Christmas cheer.

I hope that everyone who competed in a Berkeley Hills tournament or tournaments over the past year had an enjoyable experience. As we reflect on 2023 and make plans for 2024 we will be looking for ways to improve and refresh our tournament operations. My door is always open, and your suggestions and feedback are both welcome and appreciated.

Now that we're heading into the winter, we'll be playing on dormant Bermuda grass for a few months. During this time your behavior on the course will play an important role in dictating how quickly we bounce back into tournament shape next spring. I mention this in all my newsletters, but it is important to keep pull carts off the tees and away from the fringes of greens. I know it can seem like it's not a big deal, but for perspective, what condition do you think your own lawn would be in if people were permitted to wheel a cart through your grass several times per day? Whether we're riding or walking, the more we limit traffic patterns in areas where the grass is kept short the better our course conditions will be.

Also, many of you noticed how turf conditions on Hole #5 and #6 were quite nice this summer. The reason for this was in part due to enforcing cart restrictions on those holes when necessary. To that end, those holes will be Cart Path Only again this winter. Please do not be selfish and turn monitors off on golf carts to get around this restriction. And of course, please continue to repair ball marks, rake bunkers and fill divots with sand on every hole you play.

The Golf Staff would again like to thank the members of Berkeley Hills for their continued support of the Golf Shop during a great 2023 golf season. We wish all of you a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.


