





Every year in April we're reminded multiple times by commentators during Masters week that the tournament doesn't really begin until the "back nine on Sunday". And while southern country clubs operate year-round, it does feel sometimes that just as the final nine at Augusta signals the start of the "real" tournament, the actual private club season doesn't officially arrive until the month of May comes calling.

Here at Berkeley Hills you can feel the excitement in the air as we stride enthusiastically into the third month of spring. On the golf course the last remnants of dormancy are fading away as green grass, leafy trees and floral majesty in its varied technicolor shades replace the muddled brown hues of winter. Soon we'll be in the full summertime swing of things and every part of the club, from the swimming pool to the pickleball courts, will be alive with member activity.

Speaking of pickleball, I know many of our members are eagerly awaiting the upcoming addition of eight dedicated pickleball courts at the tennis center, to take the place of the temporary court setup we've utilized over the past year. The resurfacing team from Southeastern Tennis will be hard at work down at the tennis complex this month, as they take courts #5 & #6 and convert them for permanent pickleball use.

The sport of pickleball continues to explode in popularity across the country, attracting both long-time tennis players as well as individuals who are new to racquet sports. And once renovations are completed, Berkeley Hills will have one of the finest pickleball complexes in the Atlanta area. Transitioning just a few steps up the hill from the tennis & pickleball courts, the pool complex is set to reopen for member use over Memorial Weekend and its already shaping up to be a great swim season. Our Berkeley Hills Barracudas swim team will once again be representing BHCC at area swim meets, and over 90 children are signed up to participate on the team this year. Meanwhile we've got some fun member activities planned poolside for 2023, beginning with our Memorial Day Pool Party on May 29th that will feature a traditional holiday cookout along with inflatable air castles and slides, plus games & activities for all ages. You won't want to miss it!



And the fun doesn't stop there. For our members more attuned to indoor entertainment, May features an abundance of opportunities to enjoy time at Berkeley Hills. From golfers to gardeners, I think we are all ready for this wet, cool spring to be over with! Growing conditions have been less than ideal since we came out of winter dormancy, but the course is doing great considering the climate challenges we've been faced with so far this year.

I have received a lot of questions from our golfers the last few weeks wondering why certain areas of the course aren't healing up as quickly as we want them to. There are a few reasons for this. The first is that we not only had a cold winter and a (so far) cool spring, but it's also been a very wet stretch of months. Areas like the range tee and #6 fairway have experienced standing water on them for longer periods of time, which smothers the root-zone and slows the grass's rebound from dormancy.



Excess shade has also been problematic. Some of our fairways, greens and tees are impacted by both morning and afternoon shade, which stops the ground and plant roots from warming up on sunny days. And finally (and most importantly), our warm-season bermuda grass variants grow fastest in daily temperature ranges where the overnight temperatures don't go lower than the mid-60's and the daily highs reach the mid-80's. This temperature band needs to repeat itself for several consecutive 24-hour periods for the grass to really take off growing. The good news is, those days are coming soon.



Looking at our maintenance schedule this month, on May 8th and 9th the staff and I will aerify the greens with 3/8" tines. There are a few areas on the greens that tend to stay wet longer than others, and we will aerify those areas twice to help with surface drainage. Then immediately after the aerification is completed we will top dress the greens with a 45-size sand and roll the greens with an asphalt roller to help smooth them out.



Once these procedures are completed, we will hold off mowing the greens for about a week. After we resume daily mowing, we will raise the height for the first cut and then lower it each day until we get to our desired height. Once we reach that, we will begin to spray our growth regulator to help increase speed and putting quality. Our goal is for the greens to roll between 12 to 13 on the stimp meter each day of summer. It's going to be great!

Finally, regarding the areas on the greens that were damaged during the December freeze, they are showing life in most places. Where they aren't healing, we've planted bermuda grass plugs spacing them 6" apart and they will grow back throughout the summer. And post-aerification we can apply quicker-acting fertilizer to help these areas grow faster.

As always, I appreciate everyone's patience as we work through our annual spring maintenance. Please reach out with any questions or concerns.

RULES & ETIQUETTE REFRESHER

When talking about Berkeley Hills, many members remark that one thing they love about the club is that at Berkeley we aren't "pretentious" like some of those "other" clubs. Our members are here to have a good time with friends & family, and stuffiness can be left at the door.

However, just because we like to keep it casual, doesn't mean we can't look and act our casual best at the same time. And it never hurts to get a quick refresher on golf course rules and etiquette. So, as a friendly reminder for our awesome members...

Pace of Play at Berkeley Hills is 4 hours or less for 18 holes. Larger groups have priority over smaller groups and singles, but should allow faster groups to play through when the opportunity permits

Walkers may ride on a cart only when traveling from #14 green to #15 tee. If walkers are witnessed riding a cart at any other time they will be charged the applicable cart fee.

Children 21 and younger (or 23 and younger still attending college) are considered dependents. Any child whose age falls outside of this range is no longer a dependent and may only utilize the club as an accompanied guest of the primary member.

Dress code for the golf course and practice facilities stipulate that members and guests wear proper golf attire. Shirts are to be tucked in, and hats are to be worn in a forward facing position.

Pull carts and electric walking carts are not permitted on the greens surfaces at any time.

Golf bags are not permitted to be placed on the greens surfaces at any time.

All golfers keeping a handicap must post every completed 9 and 18 hole score to their GHIN handicap. The Handicap Committee will periodically review score postings for accuracy and reserves the right to make handicap adjustments for events as necessary.

BHSMGA UPDATE

The end of March is that time of year when our members make a commitment for another full year with the Berkeley Senior Men's Golf Association. During the previous year, we lost 4 members; one left Berkeley, two no longer play golf and only one decided to drop out for personal reasons. We consider a 98% retention rate a vote of confidence in what we are doing to provide our golfing members recognition and expanded golfing opportunities. In addition, we already picked up additional new members to increase our membership for the ninth straight year. Thanks for the vote of confidence. 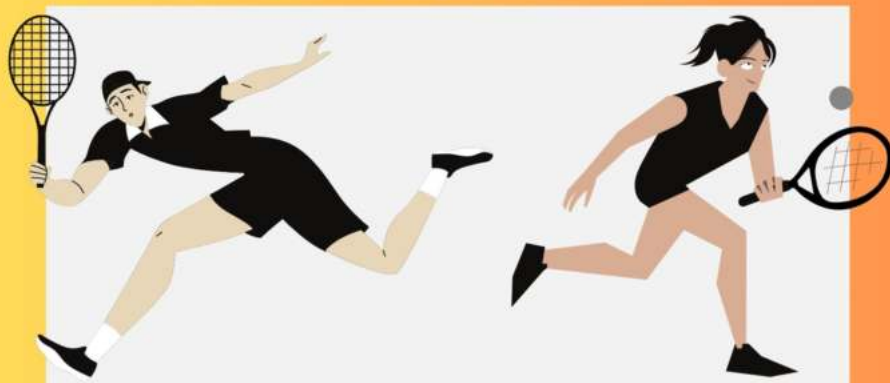

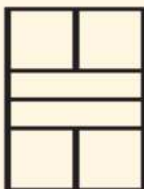

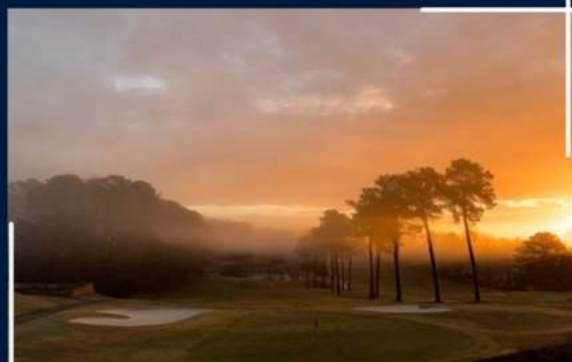
