Superintendent News November 2022

It's the time of year for frost delays. Once the temperature begins to reach into the 30's, I will leave a message on our Course Conditions line of what going on: if there is a frost or cover delay or not, and if its 90 degree or cart path only. That number is 770-448-2008 and press I for Course Conditions. It is normally updated a few minutes after sunrise. We all know what a frost delay is, but what would cause a cover delay? When we cover, normally it means the nighttime temperature is dropping into the 20's. If it's in the 50's during the day, there is a chance we will not cover and just let the greens get frosted up. But if the night is getting into the 20's and the day is in the 30's and 40's, there is a good chance we will put the covers on that afternoon to capture as much heat as we can before night. The other variable we judge by is frozen time. How long is the temperature going to be below 30 degrees. It's a guessing game. The University of Arkansas has been working on this for 15 years. Their data shows that there is not any damage until you get around 14 degrees, but I will not take that chance. It being their first year, we will be more protective of the young grass; and as the greens age, we can be less protective as they adapt to their environment.

As a reminder, the Grounds Committee has recommended we stay on the mats the entire winter to help our range tee green up better for next Spring.As of November 1st, the Range will be mats only until Springtime.


