PORT GARDNER SENIOR MEN'S CLUB

Your Senior Men's Club helps support two Junior Golf Clubs with your donations. They are the Washington Junior Golf Association (WJGA) and the Joe Richer Junior Golf club.

WJGA is a State-wide organization which supports around 1200 of our youths from ages 8 through 17. The State is split up into 6 districts and ours is District #1 which encompasses the area from Snohomish County north to the Canadian Border. Around 200 youths participate in the District and play in 6 qualifying events then the top 30% go on to the state Championship. Freddie Couples was the first State Champion and almost all of the Pros from our area participated in the program. WJGA has supported kids for almost 40 years and has about 70 unpaid volunteers across the State.

The Joe Richer Golf Club has about 200 members from the ages 8 through 18. They play about 15 events using both the Legion and Walter Hall Courses. This Club not only has a Players Club but also Players in Training, including lessons, and a 9-hole intermediate group. This Club has supported kids for over 15 years.

Both the Richer Club and WJGA include both boys and girls. They are taught:

- USGA Rules of Golf
- Respect for themselves.
- Respect for others.
- Respect and love of the Game.

All costs are subsidized through donations by both organizations and those who cannot afford the partial cost, 100% of all costs are paid. Golf clubs can be paid for those with a need belonging to the Richer Club. Your donation would be appreciated. Please include it with your annual membership.
