- **OUT OF BOUNDS.** Designated by boundary fences and/or white stakes.
- **WATER HAZARDS.** Defined by yellow lines or stakes; Lateral Water Hazards are defined by red lines or stakes.

USGA RULES SHALL GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY THESE LOCAL RULES:

- **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS.** Bulkheads, protective fences, railroad ties, fairway yardage discs, sprinkler heads, controller boxes, portable toilets, restroom buildings, water fountains, all barked and maintained flower and shrub beds, cart paths and tee monuments are all considered to be immovable obstructions.
- **150 YARD STAKES.** Are movable obstructions
- **TEMPORARY GREENS.** When a ball comes to rest on a temporary green or alternate green that is not in play, the ball must be lifted and dropped within one club length of the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole. No penalty.
- **EMBEDDED BALL.** In effect "through the green".
- **PACE OF PLAY GUIDELINES.** Slow play is a great concern for all of us. We define slow play as being more than 1 1/2 shots behind the group ahead of you. While we realize that play may be slowed due to searches for lost balls, we encourage you to keep up with the group in front of you. If you do not keep pace, we may ask you to pick up your ball and regain your position, ask you to finish your round on the Executive course or cancel your round and refund your greens fees.
