RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR RECREATION FACILITIES

Swimming Pool

The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all to assure safe and sanitary operation of the pool facilities. Your cooperation in abiding by these conditions will afford a pleasant and relaxing environment for all concerned. These rules were developed in accordance with Anne Arundel County Environmental Health codes. Parents are requested to caution their children to observe all rules and regulations and obey instructions of all employees.

Any failure to comply with these rules shall be considered sufficient cause for any action deemed necessary by management including: the barring of violators, their families and guests from the use of the pool area.

Privileges may be denied for failure to obey the rules.

All persons using the pool will be required to register with the gate guard. **No one will be admitted without a pass.**

General

All persons using the pool or pool area do so at their own risk and sole responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use. The member covenants and agrees with management and/or owners in return for the use of the pool as an added facility to make no claim against the management and/or owners, and/or agents for or on account of any loss or damage of life, limb or property sustained.

The users agree to save harmless and indemnify the management and/or owners and/or agents for any and all liabilities and action of whatsoever nature by any guest or guests resulting from the use of the swimming pool or pool area.

POOL PASSES ARE REQUIRED. Residents in **good standing** and paid members will be issued one pass for **each** household member. Pool passes will be available for pick up at the Open House and during the opening weekend of the pool during selected hours. Pool passes can be replaced for \$10 by emailing

Members are required to bring their pool pass with them every time they plan to enter the pool facilities and hand each individual pass to gate guard. Failure to have pass will result in NO ENTRY.

Children 11 years old and under must be accompanied by a person (16 and over) for admission to the pool.

- Children 12 years old and over will be permitted to use the pool unaccompanied by an adult after passing a swim test administered by the guards.

Any property damage caused by a member or their guest will be charged to the responsible member.

Management will not be responsible for loss or damage to any personal property of any kind for members or their guest.

The head lifeguard is responsible for the strict enforcement of the rules. He/she has authorization to temporarily deprive access and/or removal of any member or guest of this facility.

Health and Safety Rules

Running, pushing, wrestling, ball playing, horseplay, diving or causing undue disturbance in or about the pool area will not be tolerated.

- The lifeguards have the authority to issue warnings to troublesome behavior, and then, expel an individual from the pool.
- Those expelled cannot return to the pool without adult supervision. If more problems develop, that family's pool membership may be revoked.
- Walden Community Association will also send a letter to the parents of children who violate these rules.

Bathers cannot play on the swim lane ropes.

Pool toys or recreational equipment are authorized at guard discretion. The guards are under strict guidance to put safety first and may suspend toys or recreation equipment at any time. This includes kick boards and noodles.

During adult swim, children 16 years and above will be allowed in the pool.

A swim test (without a flotation device) may at any time be required of a child in the 4' to 5' deep area.

No pets allowed in the pool area.

Responsible eating and drinking in the pool area and on the concrete deck area immediately around the pool is permitted as long as the area is cleaned up.

- Please clean up after your family.

Strollers may be brought into the pool area. Strollers must be kept away from the edge of the pool at all times. No street footwear will be permitted on the concrete apron portion of the pool area, other than sandals and athletic shoes.

Admission shall be refused to all persons having any infectious disease, sore, or inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharges, or any communicable disease of any kind. Persons with excessive sunburn, open sores, or bandages of any kind will not be permitted into the pool.

Abusive or profane language or breach of the peace will be cause for immediate removal from the pool.

Members and their guests may bring food and non-alcoholic beverages for their personal consumption and shall be responsible for the immediate proper disposal of any containers, packaging or unused portions.

These items must be brought in non-breakable containers. **No glass is permitted in the pool area.**

Coolers may be inspected prior to entry into the pool.

Proper swimming attire is required at all times.

There will be no personal belongings hanging from fences or gates at any time.

Children that are NOT potty trained may NOT swim in the adult pool. There are no diapers/pullups allowed in the adult pool. Pool closures resulting from “accidents” will be charged to the responsible member.

No electronic music equipment can be used unless accompanied by headphones.

No smoking in the pool or pool area.

Flotation Devices

- Rafts or any other flotation devices shall not be permitted in the main pool except during special events (e.g. Raft Night).
- Noodles or kick boards are permitted to be used by patrons who can swim on their own without a flotation device.
- The use of water wings is prohibited at all times.
- Children may wear U. S. Coast Guard approved life vest (Type 2-5) or U. S. Coast Guard Puddle Jumper (Type 2) in the 2-foot area that is roped off.
- All parents must check their child in at front desk who will be using a U. S. Coast Guard approved life vest or Puddle Jumper while at the pool.
- Parents/babysitters are responsible for children while at the pool.
- Non-swimming children must be under the direct supervision of an adult.
- Noodles or swim/kick boards will only be allowed for bathers who can swim on their own, they are not considered safety devices.

Guest Policies

Members are authorized to bring guests into the pool area only when they are present and provide a valid pool pass.

- Each household will be issued 3 guest passes.
- Guest passes are non-transferable and non-replaceable.
- Guest passes **expire** at the end of the season.
- All guests must follow all rules of the pool.
- Children 12 and over are authorized to bring one guest (12 and over) unaccompanied by a household adult, provided the guest has passed the swim test.
- Members may be authorized additional guests on a cash payment basis only if in the opinion of the pool operator admitting such guests does not impair the operation of the pool or would result in an over-crowded condition.
- Guest fees are \$7.00 per guest. Guest fees will be collected by the gate guard prior to entry. Guest fees apply to all people ages three (3) years and over.
- **All guest pass usage requires the attendance of a pool member.**

Pool Parties

WCA pool members may reserve the pool for a party based on availability. Please check online at www.waldencountryclub.com for a complete set of the Pool Party Rules and an Application.

- Two tables will be reserved for private parties (such as a birthday) for a \$75 fee. A \$25 refundable security deposit is also required. This ensures the space is available before mailing invitations.
- Upon approval of application, email Admin@waldencountryclub.com or provide a list of the guests who will be in attendance. This will enable Pool Management to check in all guests efficiently. **All non-members** (swimmers or non-swimmers) who are attending the party will be charged a guest fee of \$7.
- WCA pool members will be held responsible for all actions of their guests.

WCA Pool members may reserve, based on availability, the pool for an afterhours party for an additional fee.

Unreserved pool parties are not allowed.

Wading (Baby) Pool

- Children in the wading pool must be accompanied by an adult.
- Children who are NOT potty trained are required to wear swim diapers/pullups
- Children must be five (5) years old and under to be in wading pool area.
- Parents are responsible for watching children in baby pool area.

Tennis Rules

Court availability and schedule will be posted outside of the tennis courts. Tennis courts are for pool members only and you must bring your pool pass with you each time you play.

- Shirts must be worn at all times,
- Proper tennis attire is required at all times; no bathing suits or cutoffs may be worn on tennis courts.
- Proper shoes must be worn at all times. No bare feet or flip flops allowed.
- No food or drink, except water or sport drinks, are allowed on the tennis courts.
- No music equipment is permitted on or around the tennis courts.
- No skates, roller blades, or skateboards or similar rolling devices are allowed on the courts at any time as they damage the court surface.
- Lacrosse is **not allowed** on the tennis courts at any time as it damages the court surface.
- Bikes are not allowed on the courts.
- Courts are permitted for tennis activities only.

Country Club

1. Pool members and their guests are welcome to order food and beverages from the clubhouse. When coming into the clubhouse, proper shoes and cover-ups must be worn.
2. Wait staff from the Clubhouse should be available on weekends.
3. The veranda is available for family dining before, during or after your pool experience.
