Golf Operations

The Professional Golf Management program is an all-encompassing program designed to educate interns in various segments of golf operations to include: golf course operations, golf cart fleet management, tournament operations, golf etiquette and rules, tee sheet management/ yield management, golf shop merchandising, inventory control, handicap system training, facilities and course maintenance, and golf client services.

Hospitality/Food and Beverage

The Food and Beverage program is designed to teach interns the skills specific to the hospitality side of the golf business. They will learn skills in customer service, food and beverage operations, staff scheduling, menu planning, product and inventory control, and banquet services.

Turf Care/Maintenance

The Turf Care Intern will be exposed to all aspects of golf course maintenance, including turfgrass basics, drainage/irrigation, equipment maintenance, safety, crew management, golf operations procedures, and pesticide/herbicide use.



INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENTS




Internship Eligibility

- Enrollment in an undergraduate degree-granting program with a concentration in professional golf management, hospitality or turf care
- Completion of freshman year at a degree-granting institution prior to applying for the Honours Golf Internship
- Ability to show legal eligibility to work in the United States
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 GPA scale

- Have exceptional interpersonal communication skills
- Be punctual
- Be reliable and dependable
- Be eager to learn and accept new challenges
