 The USGA and The R&A released golf's new Rules, effective January 1, 2019. Below are the most significant changes.

<p>How to Drop a Ball</p> <p>Drop your ball from knee height.</p>	<p>Leaving Flagstick in the Hole</p> <p>You may make a stroke from the green with the flagstick in the hole.</p>	<p>Other Key Changes</p> <p>You may:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Search for up to 3 minutes • Repair spike marks • Ground your club in penalty areas • Remove loose impediments in penalty areas and bunkers • Play ready golf

WE NEED YOUR EMAIL!!

With the upcoming GHIN platform changeover, one of the major things being addressed is privacy. In order to protect **your** information, your account on GHIN will be protected using a combination of your GHIN # and your email address. Once the new GHIN platform is up and running, expected to be this spring, each person will set up a profile. We'll keep you posted on when that will occur.

Each individual needs their own unique email that must not be shared with another person. For example, if a wife and husband share one email, BOTH emails will be purged from GHIN and neither person will be able to use the shared email.

- With a unique email and active OGA membership/GHIN #:
 - You will be able to post online and look up your information on GHIN.com
 - You will be able to log in and use the GHIN Mobile App
 - You will be able to post on the computer at the course
- If you do not have a unique email address:
 - The **ONLY** place you will be able to post your scores is on the computer at a Golf Course
- How to get a FREE email:
 - Most internet providers provide at least one email address as part of your account
 - Here are several standalone free email providers: Gmail, Yahoo, Outlook (Hotmail) and more
