Notes from your Saturday Captain

It's wonderful having so many players turn out for Saturday. Welcome to all our new members.

From the Golf Journal magazine this month, here is a suggestion from a Tibetan monk who plays golf. He suggests setting your intentions before your round and say to yourself "Today I'm going to remain calm and enjoy my friends".

Rules, rules, rules...some things that might not make you feel calm, but the more familiar you are with them, the better you will be able to remain calm!

The four Rules scenarios you are most likely are to encounter:

- 1. Relief from a cart path
- 2. Ground under repair
- 3. Hitting your ball into a penalty area

4. Losing your ball or hitting it out of bounds Included in the last 2 Newsletters was a link to how to take relief from a cart path. Those Newsletters can now be found posted on the Heron Lakes Women's Club site under "Documents".

Penalty areas - here is a common one we see on the Greenback hole # 13.

I hit my ball over a yellow-staked penalty area (i.e., the water on hole #13). The ball landed on the green and rolled back into the water. What are my options?

The link below is to a 4-minute explanation given by a pro at the Hong Kong Golf Club. Might be a nice place to play. Although not an official USGA explanation, he does a good job of explaining your options on our hole #13, including a situation which happened to me. I landed in the left side green side bunker, hit out and crossed the yellow penalty area mark and landed in the water.

He explains your 2 yellow penalty area options, back to where you initially played the ball and back on the line relief. A little further on he talks about your options if you hit the green but the ball rolls back into the water. Hope it helps.
