We are having a new "Lake Valley" sign made to go up on the highway. If anyone would like to make a donation towards the sign it would be very much appreciated.

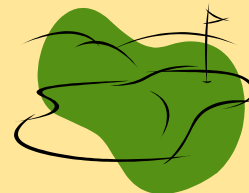

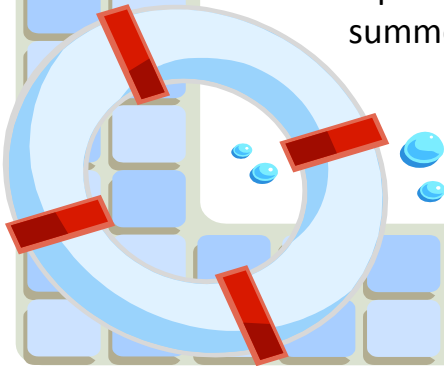
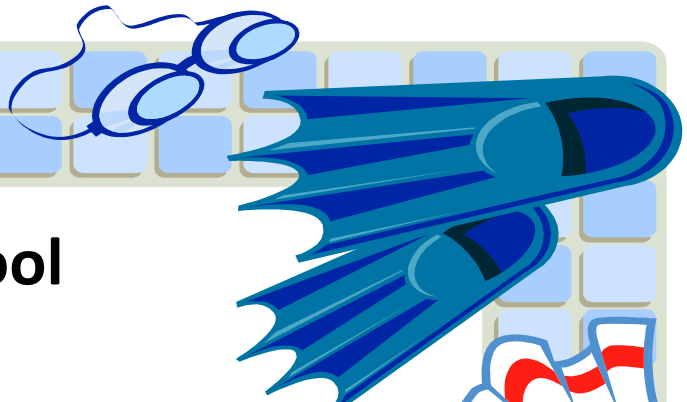

Lake Valley Party Bridge is on Wednesdays. Call Nancy Hanks at 346-5458 or Linda Martin at 346-5872 for more information.

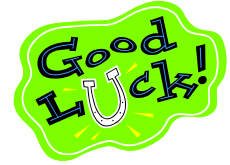


### Driving Range Packages –

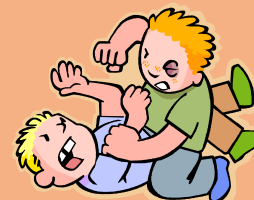
