With the golf season under way, please check your calendar for all the great upcoming golf events. Call or stop by the pro shop to register for golf events. Also a reminder, Junior Golf Camp is right around the corner. The first week is Friday June 29th and will run for 5 Fridays in a row ending on Friday July

27th. Juniors will learn the fundamentals of the game through fun contests and activities. They will also get to play golf on the course a certain number of holes depending on skill level. Please see attached file for full details and registration information.



## Junior Golf Program

Junior Golf for the 2018 season will begin on Friday June 29th and conclude on Friday July 27th. The program will consist of 5 weeks of golf, with instruction from the professional staff and a championship on Friday July 27th to conclude the 5 week camp.

**Eligibility:** Children between the ages of 7 through 18(must be under 19 years of age as of September 1st) who are sons, daughters, or grandchildren of Lancaster Country Club members, are eligible and invited to participate.

**Registration:** Telephone the golf shop at 683-1854 with your child's name, age, the number of holes he/she wishes to play. The pro will help place the junior based on previous year camp experience.

**Fees:** The charge for the 5 week program is \$80.00, payable before the start of the program. Fee includes instruction, prizes, trophies and a food buffet during the championship week Friday July 27th for camp participants.

Attention Parents and juniors: The success of this program depends upon your participation and cooperation.

- 1. 6 hole and 4 hole juniors must have a parent or grandparent assist a minimum of two Friday's per child enrolled. 3 Hole juniors must have a parent or grandparent each week. You will walk with one of the Jr. groups to help keep score, teach etiquette, interpret rules and keep things moving. It is very important the parents are here with the children. If you are uncomfortable with the rules and etiquette, please ask the golf shop for guidelines. Inform the golf shop for dates and times you are available to help. This is mandatory this season.
- 2. Please encourage your child to practice. Review the rules of golf and

etiquette with him/her. Any misconduct may result in immediate disqualification.

- 1. Ir. Golfers must have their own equipment.
- 2. Proper attire is mandatory- Proper dress is Bermuda length shorts, and a shirt with a collar, shirts must be tucked in for boys and sleeves. EXAMPLES OF UNCCEPTABLE ATTIRE: TEE SHIRTS, MUSCLE SHIRTS, JEANS, CUT-OFFS, TENNIS SHORTS, JAMS, CARGO SHORTS, OVERSIZED SHIRTS, ETC.
- 3. Every player **must be on time** for the lesson and ready to tee-off at the appointed time. Parents please impress upon your child the importance of being on time.

**Notice to Adult Golfers:** The practice tee **will be closed** to all adults until **11:30 A.M.** on junior golf Fridays. <u>Members are asked to avoid play on Jr. Golf mornings.</u> This season junior golf occurs one morning a week for 5 weeks. Friday, June 29th through Friday, July 27th. We ask for your cooperation and expect you treat the Junior Golfers with the courtesy and respect that you expect from them. THANK YOU!!

Tee-times will be assigned! Juniors must walk and carry their own golf bag.

#### Special Rules for 3, 4, & 6-Hole Walking Parents

- A. Count all swings including whiffs.
- B. After 2 whiffs, carry the ball 10 steps forward and play again. (The purpose of this rule is to speed up play.)
- C. After 10 strokes, pick up the ball, proceed to the green and putt out. Count all of the number of putts and add to the 10 for a total on that hole.
- D. Count all penalty strokes for water hazards, out of bounds, and lost balls.
   1-stroke for ball in the water
   1-stroke and distance (must replay from original position) for out of bounds
   1-stroke and distance for lost ball (must replay form original position)

#### Rules for All Walking Parents

- Keep juniors moving and proceeding safely.
- Watch for juniors who are not raking bunkers, replacing divots, or repairing ball marks.
- C. Help juniors with proper rules of golf & etiquette.
- D. Correct juniors who are clowning around.
- E. Alert juniors to come in off the course if you see lightning or a storm approaching.
- F. Carry extra scorecards, pencils and tees.
- G. Keep a rule book handy. Juniors should have one in their bag.






