A Message from Your General Manager

Dear Valued Lancaster Members,

The long winter has finally left us and now the excitement of spring is in the air. I wanted to review the fiscal year of 2018 as we closed out the year in February. The team did an exceptional job in rightsizing our labor to align with our revenues. This proper alignment resulted in lowering the overall labor of the club by \$61,069 compared to prior year. Additionally, the team managed to save \$74,655 in operational expenses as compared to prior year. Both savings were vital to our success as we continued to battle against a reduced dues line. The dues line was down \$151,738 as compared to prior year. One of the biggest improvements in the club was the F&B department. Although we are still trying to achieve a breakeven bottom line, the team was able to improve the departments net by \$80,813 over prior year. In summary, EBITDA for the fiscal year of 2018 was \$71,560 as compared to \$29,594 in 2017. The complete income statement can be found on the members' side of the website under financials.

Membership sales have been very good thus far in 2019. We have welcomed over 20 new members into our family. Many thanks to all the members who have referred a new member into the club. Your support is greatly appreciated and certainly makes closing new members much more effective. I am hoping that together we can duplicate or even beat the 74 new members that we welcomed into the club in 2018. If you have anyone that may be interested in entertaining membership, we would be happy to host them as a "Member for a Day". Simply contact Greta Dankert or myself and we can make the arrangements.

As we move into the prime season for golf, events and activities, it will be imperative to get connected using Clubster. This is the new hub for all the communications for the club. You can also use the app to make tee times, reservations and reference other links such as the new rules of golf. If you have not downloaded the app I would highly recommend doing so soon. If you need help, please contact Greta Dankert or Kevin Roberts. They would be happy to assist.



The previously passed policy for Mothers Day will be available again this season. The policy now opens up tee time restrictions for Associate Spouse Members to be able to play earlier than 10am. Associate Spouse Members may call or use the online tee time system up to 7 days in advance for an unrestricted tee time so they may get home earlier to enjoy the Holiday with their families. The Mothers Day Holiday for 2019 falls on Sunday May 12th. Please contact the golf shop for further information.

Reminders as we start the new season:

- Tee Times have begun and are available online. When booking a reservation, please fill out the member last name you are playing golf with. Please do not use "Member" as a place holder for the reservation. If you are bringing a guest to the club, you may put "Guest" as the player name. You can only have one guest in the 4some before 10am on weekend & Holidays. Please call the golf shop or go online to cancel your reservation if you are not able to make it. Our Membership roster has grown versus last season and the availability during busy times will be at a premium. Every effort will be made to pair up players into 4somes or 3somes during the busy times for pace of play assistance.
- -Dress Code reminder; please inform your guests before they come out to play on the most common over sights: shirts tucked in for men, no denim or jeans and no cargo shorts or pants. Members and Guests will be expected to change or purchase shorts as exterior cargo pockets will not be permitted on course. The golf shop will extend a discount to those needing to purchase shorts.
- -On Course Etiquette of raking bunkers, filling divots and repairing ball marks on the green is always expected and appreciated as you play your round. Please be aware of your spacing on the course in relation to the group in front of you. If you see open room in front of your group and find players waiting on your group behind you, please invite them to play through at the first opportunity. Please refrain from cutting holes in front of groups or starting on the back 9 unless the golf shop gives you permission. If ordering food from the half-way house, please pick up and continue play. If you sit to eat, you will lose your place on the course when busy and might be forced to start over on hole #1 if a tee time is available to finish your round. Finally, 2 golf carts per group max please. If running late or coming at a different time than playing partners, our staff can give you a ride out to join your group already in progress.
- -If you ever have questions on any of the reminders or something else golf related, please ask us in the golf shop, as we are here to help with your golf experience. See you at the Club!



Update from the Grounds Department

This spring has been a trying one to say the least. The weather has not cooperated with us and as a result has delayed our renovation projects, and fairway aerification. The fairway aerification is a moving target at this point and will be performed as soon as the conditions allow.

Our greens were aerified and are almost completely healed in. We will start to lower the height on greens throughout the month of May. This year we will also topdress the greens a bit more frequently than we did last year. Topdressing helps smooth the playing surfaces along with diluting the thatch layer. Tee decks will be aerified starting this week. We will be solid tining (no plug pulled) followed with topdressing with sand and overseeding them.

We are hoping for better weather so we can all enjoy the golf course soon.
