Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Manage the irrigation system operation, maintenance and repair as needed
- Maintain course equipment, maintenance, repairs, and supplies as needed
- Hire and supervise seasonal support staff and train as needed
- Oversees employees in proper and safe operation and maintenance of mechanical and power equipment
- Supervise and participate in the application and recording of chemical applications (fertilizers and pesticides) on the Club's grounds in compliance with all local, state, and federal regulations
- Demonstrate continuous effort to streamline and improve operations
- Develop and adhere to an annual budget and work with The Board of Directors to operate in a fiscally responsible manner
- Plan and budget for additional or replacement capital equipment
- Must be able to work independently and be a self-starting problem solver
