The booking system lottery is now open with the first lottery taking place on Saturday, October 9. Please remember to give the system lots of options by expanding your time and location requests. Both single and doubles play are permitted. You must add all names into the booking request. If you apply for singles play in the lottery you are expected to play singles. There will be no chits signed to minimize interaction and all names on casual booking will be invoiced.

Covid Protocols

Once again, we start the season with Covid protocols. The clubhouses due to the small sizes have limited access as we are limited to 50% capacity. With the size of the bubbles, we can run both single and double.

I remind you that photo ID and proof of two vaccinations is required for all members to enter the club. This is a government regulation, and we cannot store this data so each time you come you'll have to show it.

We must wear a facemask to enter the club house as well as the bubble. You do not have to wear a mask while playing. When you arrive, please sanitize your hands as you enter or exit the club house and bubble.

We will also limit interaction between court changes by using separate entrances and exits. While inside whether it is in the bubble or in the clubhouse, please maintain 6 feet of separation.

Floor spacing stickers have been installed in the club houses to provide social distancing places to stand while waiting to play in the event you happen to be in the club house. We encourage you to arrive dressed for tennis as the bathroom areas are limited to 2 persons and only for washroom

use. Showers will be unavailable at this time. Please arrive no earlier than 5 minutes prior to your start time. This will limit unneeded interactions and help maintain social distancing protocols. Playing partners waiting to enter should stand together on the social distancing markers with their masks on while maintain the 6 foot distancing.

All playing times will be 55 minutes allowing for limited contact. Please do not delay your departure as it will affect those waiting to play.

For your safety we will continue to have hand sanitizer available throughout the facility.
