### **House News**

Dear WGC members and Guests,

I have taken over the House Committee Chair effective 1 November. I am encouraged that at this point in the year the House is operating at a profit for the year, well ahead of the past two years which were impacted by Covid restrictions. As we look ahead to the winter months, we know there will be a significant reduction in the number of golfers and diners due to weather. Therefore, WGC will be limiting some of our hours, with the flexibility to remain open if business is adequate. The reduction in hours is not that significant, but the decision was not one that the Board took lightly. It just is not prudent to maintain maximum House hours when there are not enough customers to break even (we are trying to safeguard the progress made year to date). The below are the expected House "Off Season" hours ... we will remain flexible to adjust if needed:



The plan for now is to have fun Thursday competitions, twice each month from March through October. One competition will be an 18-hole event with a 1:00 Shotgun start. The other competition will be a 9-hole event with a 4:00 shotgun start. The later start for the 9-hole event is to hopefully allow some of our members who work a chance to participate with the group.

Almost all of the events will be a blind draw for partners, so everyone will sign up as individuals and the Pro Shop will make up teams, depending on what games we are playing for the event. Members are encouraged to bring guests (reduced green fee rates) to the event and the Pro Shop will ensure that the member and guest play together, if desired.

As a trial run, we held an 18-hole event at the end of September and a 9-hole event in October. The first one (September 29, 1:00 Shotgun) was a Shamble format and we had 42 golfers sign up. It was followed by a taco bar social mixer up in the bar and everyone had a great time. The second one (October 20, 4:00 Shotgun) had 24 golfers and was followed with a buffet social. Considering the number of people out of town and short notice, it was a great turnout for both events, and the interest/enthusiasm to continue these seems to be very high.


