Penalty Area (Water Hazard) Boundaries

Each time I play in the winter it seems we are always faced with a question of where the water hazard line really is. We do not mark the hazard areas with paint during the winter. Since many of the hazards have so many twists and turns in them, going from stake to stake can often be unrealistic. If there is no painted line and it is unrealistic to use the stakes, please use the mow line. The hazard line will be where the uncut area starts.

Long & Wrong Scramble

This tournament is in it's 9th year and will test everyone's ability to hit long approach shots and drain long putts. "What is a Long & Wrong Scramble?" It's a scramble like no other! Put together a team of 4 and come out to see a whole new course. There will be some shorter tees for the seniors and women that will make them competitive.
