We are excited to share that the Golf Course and Practice Facility are currently under renovation. Special points of interest are listed below, but please feel free to reach out to our team with any questions or concerns that you might have at any point throughout the process. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience and we looked forward to sharing updates periodically.

We are working on the installation of Primo UltraDwarf Zoysia. Why you ask?

- Less mowing requirements allows maintenance staff to focus on course detail
- Less fertility requirements than Bermuda or Bentgrass
- Low water requirements, turf performs better in heat and dry conditions
- Requires less sunlight than Bermuda or Bentgrass
- Grass produces more consistent speeds than Bermuda or Bentgrass with less inputs meaning you will enjoy a consistent putting surface without seeing aggressive maintenance practices.

Next up, Irrigation System upgrades. What does this mean?

- Installation of new Toro LTC Series Irrigation Clocks
 - Flowsafe Protects flow managed programs in the event of a central or wireline interruption. No single point of failure means programs will run even if the central computer is offline.
 - Communication Options Wireless, wireline, and hybrid configurations allow the user to customize the communication network to meet specific site needs.
 - Ability to add additional watering stations as needed.
 - Ability to program 16 independent stations, with up to eight running simultaneously.
- Upgrades to our pump station to include pump rebuilds and new operating system.
- Reconditioning of existing fertigation system which will allow the injection of chemicals and fertilizers straight into the irrigation system.

 - Adding sand
- Tie in drainage basins in select fairways that have sunk or become compromised

Crooked Creek Club to Undergo \$1.3 Million Renovation

Revitalization Project Includes Golf Course and Clubhouse Enhancements

(**RESTON, VA**) – Crooked Creek Club – a Billy Casper Signature-managed golf club 30 miles north of Atlanta – will undergo a \$1.3 million renovation encompassing both the golf course and clubhouse.

The first step in the multi-staged project will be renovating the greens and converting the turf from Bent Grass to Primo Zoysia. The new grass type is a more suitable choice for Crooked Creek's southern climate as it tolerates shade, thrives in heat and is less susceptible to disease. This change will provide the Club with more sustainable turf through summer heat and an overall stronger plant for future playability. Director of Agronomy Mark Patterson and his team have begun prepping the greens for this renovation.

The course is scheduled to close from June 1 to late August. During the closure, major improvements to the irrigation system are also planned. Additional course enhancements include improving bunkers, leveling tee surfaces and beautifying perimeters to rejuvenate course appearance and playability. A new fleet of maintenance equipment for quality turf care and new golf carts equipped with the latest technology will complete the project.

The practice facility will also get a facelift with the installation of a permanent, high quality mat running along the back edge of the range tee plus new bag stands, chairs and tee dividers.

"This project will transform Crooked Creek from a good course that has lacked necessary attention into a great one with a greens turf product that will lead the industry," says Matt Wilson, National Director of Operations for Billy Casper Signature. "We know with a greatly improved product, a hardworking on-site team and a loyal, engaged membership base, Crooked Creek Club will be a case study for success. We are anxious for the local market, as well as former members, to give Crooked Creek another look when deciding on club membership."
