The first round of our Capital projects is almost completed. The maintenance team has laid all of the purchased sod on holes #1, #9, #10 and #18. They will continue to roll and top dress these areas over the next few weeks to insure the best possible playing conditions. You can already see what a great improvement this will make on the course.

We have also completed the cart path repair beside #10 tee box. Over the years we have had a severe drainage problem in this area that has caused our cart path to crack and collapse to the point that it was a hazard to all that used the cart path. I'm glad to say this is now behind us.

I'm sure you have noticed that we have trimmed the oleanders along the fence at the pool. By doing this it now allows us to paint / stain the fence. We have almost completed the outside perimeter and once completed we will start on the inside. We believe this will enhance the overall appearance of the pool area as well as preserve the fence.

Finally, we hope to have the pool open soon. We have experienced multiple equipment problems that have prevented proper circulation thus leaving the water dis-colored. We have identified the problems and will make the necessary repairs. We hope to have the pool open for everyone soon.

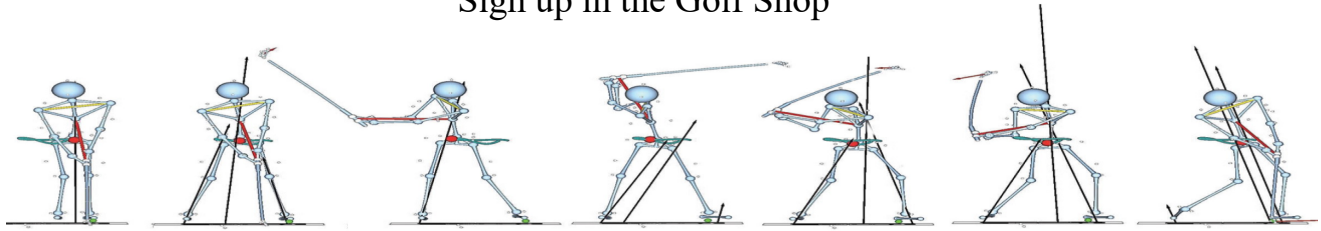

Course Update~ Derick Hashimoto

April was a busy month as we finished up the sod work on #10. The extra sod was used on hole #9 to complete the project. We also completed our first greens aerification for 2021. It went well, and we should see a quick recovery from are aerification.

In May, we will be addressing some of are weak areas on the greens. This process will consist of removing sub-surface material to promote a better growing base. Once completed the repaired are-as will be re-sodded.

We will also continue to work on these high focus areas:

- Removal of the St. Augustine grass from the playing areas. This will be a slow process before it is all gone but we are working towards that goal.

- We will continue to manage traffic control ropes in the playing area to assist with the grow in

Finally, we need your help in assisting us with cart traffic, we are seeing more areas on the course showing signs of the additional cart traffic. PLEASE avoid weak areas and PLEASE observe all cart rules throughout the course.

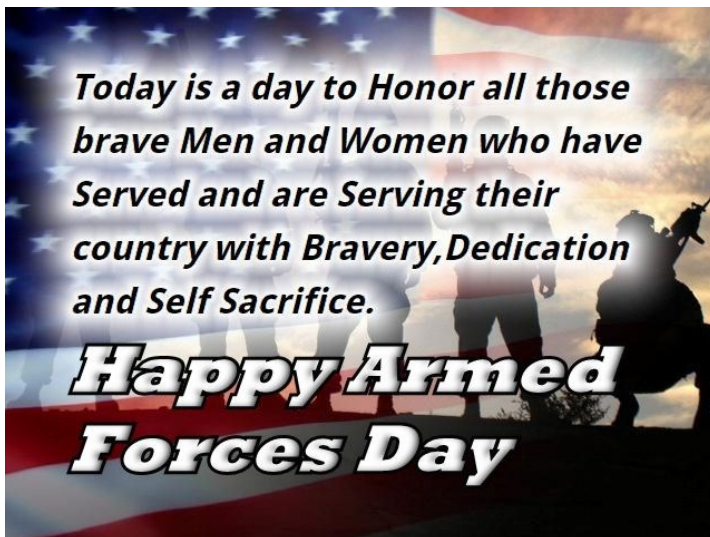

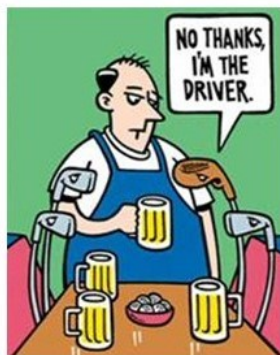
