Message from the President-Craig Bohn

As President I have many members come to me with questions about the club. How are we doing, what does the future hold etc. I also have members ask about various club rules and enforcement. I remind members that a copy of the rules and regulations are located on the RCC website and our management staff can also provide a copy if needed.

The two most common questions are "clubhouse and golf course attire / dress code" and "golf cart" rules. Clubhouse attire guidelines may be found under Rule #5 in the club Rules and Regulations and course attire guidelines are found under Golf Rules and Regulations section #1. Also found in the Golf Section are Golf Cart rules that are located in Golf section #6.

Every member is responsible for knowing the club rules and regulations for themselves and guest. The most common infractions are Hats / Caps in the dining room and golf carts getting too close to the greens. The rules state that men MAY NOT wear hats / caps in the dining room after 5:00 pm. Hats / Caps may be worn at the bar and glass room but must be facing forward and golf carts must remain at least 10 yards from the greens at all times.

Club Update – Clubhouse Dress Code Update

The Board of Directors have updated the Club Rules and Regulations dress code for the club-house. This rule modification is in place to clarify specific language regarding Rule #5. The updated rule reads as follows:

Attire. The club is located in a community known for its casual, inviting, and outdoors atmosphere. It is the club's intent to reflect this atmosphere as most inviting to members and guests. Consistent with this intent, the following guidelines shall apply to attire. Proper attire is required at all times in the public areas of the clubhouse. Casual clothing for both day and evening wear is acceptable, including suitable golf and tennis attire, for both ladies and gentlemen. However, cutoffs, pants with patches or holes, bathing suits, halter tops, tank tops and other comparable clothing are not acceptable. Shoes or other appropriate footwear are required of all members and guests in all areas of the clubhouse. *Appropriate hats/caps may* be worn in the clubhouse before during and after a round of golf but must face forward at all times. Men may not wear hats/caps in dining areas and or during special club functions or private events except when special circumstances make them appropriate (following a golf tournament). Further, men may not wear hats in the member dining areas at dinner time (after 5:00 pm). Hat / Caps are permitted at the bar seating and glass room following a round of golf. Children are required to conform to the same dress code as adults. Members are responsible for advising their guests of the appropriate attire while visiting the club and for any events. Members should not confront any other member or guest at the club and make any comments about possible attire non-compliance. Rather, they should discretely bring the matter to the attention of management on duty and allow management to address the situation



Chef Chris Shares a favorite Recipe



To me, food is a way to bridge gaps between great divides. Whether it is distance or time, food brings us together and makes those gaps seem not so far.. So here is a recipe that has brought my family together since I was a child, Hungary Goulash.

Goulash

Severs 6

2 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil
1 medium yellow onion, chopped
2 cloves garlic, minced
1 lb. ground beef
Kosher salt, to taste
Freshly ground black pepper, to taste
1 tbsp. tomato paste
1 '/4 Cup beef broth
1 (15-oz) can tomato sauce
1 (15-oz) can diced tomatoes
1 tsp Italian seasoning
1 tsp. paprika
1 '/2 cups macaroni elbow, uncooked
1 cup shredded cheddar
Freshly chopped parsley, for garnish

In a large skillet over medium heat, heat oil. Add onion and cook until soft, about 5 minutes. Add garlic and cook until fragrant, about 1 minute more.

Add ground beef and cook until no longer pink, about 6 minutes. Drain fat and return to pan. Season with salt and pepper.

Add tomato paste and stir to coat, then pour in broth, tomato sauce, and diced tomatoes.

Season with Italian seasoning and paprika, and stir in macaroni. Bring to a simmer and cook, stirring occasionally, until pasta is tender, about 15 minutes.

Stir in cheese and remove from heat. Garnish with parsley before serving.
