

The maintenance team has had a tremendous focus on the greens recovery from last year and by looking at the photos below you will see some major improvement. In addition to greens, they are working towards the removal of the St. Augustine grass on the course. This will take some time but we are working towards that goal.

We have aerified all tees and fairways, verti-cut all of the fairways, preformed water and soil test all in effort to better understand our course and to improve the overall playing conditions. We are now in the process of adding a tif-eagle nursery at the practice area. Again, all for the betterment of the club and improving the playing conditions on the course.

My expectations are that we will continue to see improvements on the course and that RCC will be the finest private club in the Texas costal bend.





Course Update~ Derick Hashimoto

August is here and we have a few exciting things going on this month. We are currently working on the chipping green to the right of the driving range. This area will be converted from a chipping green to a tif-eagle nursery. The process will include stripping away the old turf and to spray it to kill off any roots left behind. Step two will be to sprig the green around August 10th. This new surface will be maintained at greens height that will serve as a nursery and additional putting surface. This grow in process should take about 6-8 weeks until complete.

We will also continue to work on these high focus areas

- * The final core aerification will be done on the greens August 17th and 18th.
- * Removal of the St. Augustine grass from the playing areas. This will be a slow process before it is all gone but we are working towards that goal.
- * Continue to work on the weak turf areas on the greens, tees and fairways. These areas are getting a heavy dose of fertilizer to assist the process
- * We will continue to manage traffic control ropes in the playing area to assist with the grow in Finally, we need your help in assisting us with cart traffic. With the single cart use program we are seeing more areas on the course showing signs of the additional cart traffic. PLEASE avoid weak areas and PLEASE observe all cart rules throughout the course.


