Did you know that at the end of December 2021 we had 609 total members at RCC. This is 100 more members than we had on December 31, 2018 when we moved into our newly re-modeled clubhouse. These are great steps forward for our club and I'm excited about the future.

One of the reasons we have had such member growth is because of you! Did you know that in 2021 we gave out almost \$5000 in member referral credits! These are credits to our existing members for bringing new members to the club. We have no better resource than you and your referrals. Thank you.

Finally, due to the Paycheck Protection Program and the Employee Retention Credit we received from the US Government we were able to pay off an existing bank loan from 2005. Member growth, less debt are both very positive steps for RCC.

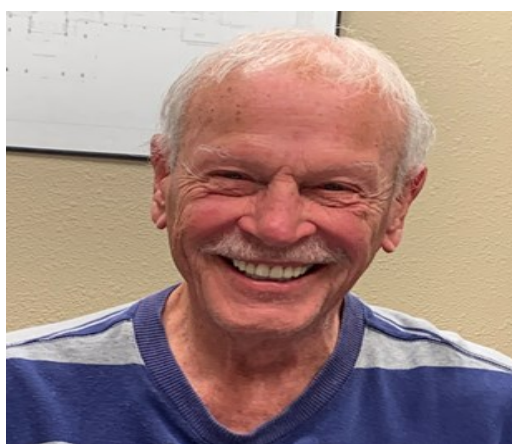

We would like to welcome Pat Ray as our newest member. If you have any questions, suggestions or concerns please feel free to contact a board member.

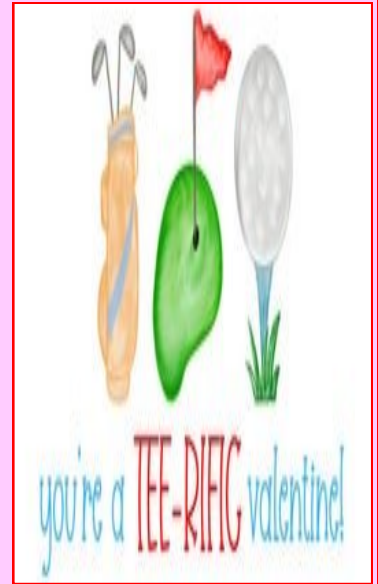
