Course Update~ Derick Hashimoto

February was an interesting month for golf Course maintenance. We started out by beginning the sod project on holes 1, 9 and 10. We removed all weak areas including contaminated soil and will replace with paspalum sod. Then the extreme cold weather hit that covered all of our turf with ice for 3 days. This put our grass into dormancy which is a plants self-defense for cold weather. Over the next month you will see the grass start to green up as we warm up.

We will also continue to work on these high focus areas:


- Removal of the St. Augustine grass from the playing areas. This will be a slow process before it is all gone but we are working towards that goal.

- We will continue to manage traffic control ropes in the playing area to assist with the grow in
