In addition, we have completed the long overdue tree trimming project and now will continue on with our projects list to better the course. These projects include drainage, weak areas on greens and fairways and general turf quality throughout the course.

Finally, your RCC Greens Committee has started its monthly meeting again. The Greens Committee consist of Bruce Hood (Chair), Jeff Hulse, Belinda Hulse, Dan Holitzke and Red Hunt.
