

Course Update~ Derick Hashimoto

August was a busy month and is now behind us. As everyone has noticed the lack of rain and extreme heat has created some hot spots on the course. We will continue to make every effort to manage these areas until we get some much needed rain. We were lucky that we dodged some of the extreme weather (hurricanes) that moved through the gulf this past month.

We did complete the last greens core aerification for the year. The new chipping green / nursery is coming around nicely. We will continue to top dress and roll and begin mowing the green soon to get it into playing condition.

In September we will apply our fall pre emerge. This process will help to prevent fall and winter weeds. Weed control has been an on-going problem and we will continue to address with various controlled applications.

We will also continue to work on these high focus areas

• Removal of the St. Augustine grass from the playing areas. This is a slow process and will take time before it is all gone. We are however working towards that goal.

• Continue to work on the weak turf areas on the greens, tees and fairways. These areas are getting a heavy dose of fertilizer to assist the process.

• We will continue to manage traffic control ropes in the playing area to assist with the grow in

Finally, we need your help in assisting us with cart traffic. With the single cart use program, we are seeing more areas on the course showing signs of the additional cart traffic. PLEASE avoid weak areas and PLEASE observe all cart rules throughout the course.
