

TENNIS / PICKLE BALL / BOCCE BALL

- 1. Courts will be open daily from 8:00 am 10:00 pm.
- 2. Ball Machine is available for use via Salix reservations: <u>www.salixreservations.com</u>. Facility Code is **tpresident**. Membership is required, See Pat for details.
- 3. Only balls that have been provided may be used with the Ball Machine. Standard tennis balls are not permitted and will damage the Ball Machine.
- 4. Advance reservations may be scheduled 7 days in advance online at <u>www.salixreservations.com</u>. Facility Code is **tpresident**. Members should contact the Racquet Sports Director directly for assistance when faced by an online reservation issue. Racquet Sports Director will not accept reservations from voicemail, or instant messages.
- 5. Members may only reserve 1 court at a time; and member must be on reserved courts at all times. Stacking of reservations is not allowed.
- 6. As a matter of courtesy, members are expected to cancel reservations online, or to call the Racquet Sports Director at least 24 hours in advance to notify their cancellation. Members who abuse the court reservation system, or don't use the courts they reserve without canceling or notifying Racquet Sports Director on 5 different occasions during any calendar, year may have their right to sign up for events and/or court times suspended at the discretion of the Racquet Sports Director and Management.
- 7. Recurring racquet sports calendar events will be reserved in advance by Racquet Sports Director.

- 8. Members and their guests using the courts will conduct themselves in a courteous manner with regard to the rights of others.
- 9. Members and their guests must obtain and complete a waiver form from the Management Company prior to use of the courts.
- 10.Members and their guests shall have the right to use the courts at any time the courts are available for open play, at their own risk. Refer to Guest Policy for information. Member must be on court with Registered Day Guest at all times.
- 11.Courts shall not be used for any other purpose than tennis, pickleball, or bocce unless otherwise determined and permitted by the Board on a case by case basis.
- 12.No food shall be permitted on the courts.
- 13.Non-playing children or adults on bikes, scooters, rollerblades or skates are not permitted on the courts.
- 14.Players must be courteous to others. For the safety and enjoyment of other Members and their guests, please refrain from excessive noise, profanity, and unsportsmanlike behavior.
- 15.Do not lean or climb on nets, fences, etc.
- 16. The court lights will be automatically turned off at times determined by Management.
- 17. Court shoes must be worn at all times while on the Courts. Black soled shoes and running shoes are not permitted.
- 18.Men's attire shall consist of shorts, shirts, and/or appropriate warm-up suits.
- 19. Women's attire shall consist of shorts, shirts, skirts, tennis dresses, and/or appropriate warm-up suits.

- 20. Under the direction of the Racquet Sports Director, only authorized staff members or tennis contractors have exclusive authority to solicit, offer, or provide member services (including but not limited to tennis lessons, clinics, or instruction) on club property or facilities.
- 21. The members shall be entitled to invite their guests to use the tennis/pickleball/bocce courts with all its rights and privileges, and in exercise of the privileges all are expected to conduct and to attire themselves as ladies and gentlemen and to conform to all guest rules.
- 22.Guests may only be allowed to play in club round robins or any racquet sports sponsored activities only after all members have signed up and space still available. Members must communicate their intensions to invite a guest to the club's events directly with the Racquet Sports Director. Guests will not be able to use the online Reservation System to sign up on any club event or tennis program.
- 23. Tennis, Pickleball, and Bocce Leagues must receive prior approval from Racquet Sports Director. All League playing time must be approved by Racquet Sports Director. League Captain must be a homeowner. Captain is responsible for providing Racquet Sports Director and Gate House attendants with League name and schedule at least 24 hours in advance of practice and/or league match.
- 24.Court 4 will be available for Reservations Monday through Friday all day. If Court 4 is not reserved, it can be used for All Play. Should Racquet Sports Director determine this practice is being abused, policy will be revised.

HOW TO SIGN UP FOR SALIX RESERVATION SYSTEM:

- 1. Go to <u>www.salixreservations.com</u>.
- 2. Click on "Player Signup/Login".
- 3. Click on "Create New Member Account".
- 4. Click on the down arrow at the top of the screen (it will be a blank menu with a red asterisk next to it).
- 5. Select "Resident Member" (if you are renting a home in the community, please select "Transfer Member").
- 6. Click on blank space next to "Facility Code" and enter tpresident
- 7. Click in the blank next to "Find Club" and enter **The Place at Corkscrew**, then click "Find".
- 8. Click on the entry labeled "The Place at Corkscrew" & click the blue "Next" button.
- 9. Fill out all entries to create your profile (red asterisk fields are mandatory, the rest are optional).
