

Updated Spring 2021

Please review the following information before visiting Colwood Golf Center. We have procedures in place to help protect the health of our staff and guests. Please adhere to our social distancing measures: please remain at least 6' from others at all times, everywhere on property. **A face mask or face covering is required anytime 6' of distance cannot be maintained. This includes all indoor and outdoor areas.**

### Facilities

- A face mask/face covering will be required everywhere on property when 6' of distance between others cannot be maintained.
- Access to restrooms is available inside the clubhouse at the rear entrance to the golf shop. Enter through the lobby door. A mask/face covering is required while inside.
- The golf shop will be restricted to staff only. Check in for golf at the front window.

### Booking a Tee Time (2 options):

- Online: Booking online is the preferred method, so we can limit the number of phone calls in the golf shop.
  - *Note: if you book online, you still have to pay at the course or over the phone. Online payment for your tee time is not currently available.*
- Call in: Call and book over the phone. Please note, you may experience delays due to high call volume.

### Paying your Green Fee (2 options for credit card payments – we are NOT accepting cash at this time):

- Pay at Check-in: located at the payment window in the golf shop entryway.
- Pay over the phone: call before you arrive, or call from the parking lot and we can accept your credit card payment over the phone. Please make sure you know your tee time, this information is imperative to our staff in accepting a phone payment and checking you in.

### Golf Cart Use

- Power Carts will be available on dry weather days when course conditions allow for it.
  - We have a limited supply of power carts. Availability is first come, first served.
  - Please wear a mask when riding in a cart with someone who is not in your household.
- Pull Carts are available for rent as well, on a first come, first served basis.
- This equipment is cleaned and sanitized between each use for the health and safety of our guests.

### Driving Range

- Purchase your range balls either over the phone or in person at the window to the golf shop – then proceed to the “self-serve” table outside the golf shop to pick up your full, sanitized basket.
- After hitting, return your empty basket to the white sanitizing buckets located in the middle of the range area.
  - *Note: sanitizing buckets are a liquid bleach mixture, and very potent. Watch your clothing.*
- Our range stalls are 10' wide, which accomplishes social distancing when remaining on the hitting mat.
- Avoid using benches and other fixtures on the range. Limit touching of all fixtures.

### Food & Beverage

- We offer snacks and beverages for sale at the golf shop. These are “to-go” items.
- Our restaurant has remained closed for in-person dining, and currently we do not have a re-open date set yet.

### On the Golf Course

- Leave the pin in the cup. Don't touch the flag sticks.
- Repair your ball marks and divots please.
- We do not have cart paths, so be mindful of soft/wet spots if you are riding in a golf cart. Keep carts away from the putting greens.
