PHEASANT RIDGE GOLF CLUB TUESDAY NIGHT TWILIGHT LEAGUE

TEAMS

Two-Man teams with no handicap restrictions. You may select a partner or enter a random draw to be teamed with a partner. The league dues are \$60.00 per person which will pay for prizes and administration of league We **must receive the league dues before league play starts. The \$60 dues will not be refundable after the first two weeks of league**. The price of \$20.00 will be due each Tuesday for greens fees.

TYPE OF PLAY

We will be using the match play format. Opponents will be randomly drawn, with each week bringing a new opponent. Each match will be played for a total of nine points. Each hole will be worth one point. A "show-up" point will also be awarded to the team as an incentive if both members of the team "show-up".

"SHOW-UP" POINTS

If a team is forced to play a match with one player or the team recruits a substitute, the "show-up" point will be cut in half.

Additionally, no "show-up" point will be awarded to a team that has recruited two subs to play a match. A match can still be played by a team that recruits two subs providing that certain etiquette is followed in making match arrangements. If proper notification is given to opponents about whom they will be playing and what time the tee time will be, then the opponents will be obliged to play the match. If the arrangements are not satisfactorily arranged, then the team may elect to play a randomly drawn card from league play that night. <u>It is not up to the Pro Shop or anyone else running the league to find substitutes or arrange matches.</u>

SUBSTITUTES

If a player is unable to make a match, the team is encouraged to find a substitute to fill in. The sub must have an established handicap. Substitutes are eligible to play in the weekly matches, however, will NOT be allowed to play in the championship tournament unless a medical issue occurs with a team member. Prior approval to the match must be cleared.

MATCHES WITH A NO SHOW TEAM

When a team is scheduled to play another team that is unable to make it they will be randomly drawn to play the card of another team that is playing that night. The team that did show-up that night cannot receive less than 4.5 points (plus show-up points) but can earn more with matching of the cards. It is strongly encouraged that if you know that you are going to be out that you try to make arrangements with your opponents to play your match at an earlier time or find a substitute. If a team is unable to make a match and they have not found substitutes or pre-arranged for an earlier time or day to play their opponents they will receive zero points for that match. Matches must be played against your opponents on the same day and in the same group!!!

PLAYOFF TOURNAMENT

The top 8 teams in each division, determined by your point total, will be placed in oneday tournament to determine the order of finish for the top 16 teams in the league. Only the 1st place team in each division determined by match points will have a chance to be "League Champions". Ex: 1st place Division A will play 1st place division B (for 1st & 2nd). 2nd place Division A will play 2nd place Division B (for 3rd & 4th) and so on...This will establish a final order of teams for prizes. Any ties in point totals for determining your Division Final standing will be first broken by **attendance**. If the tie is not broken by attendance, then a series of randomly drawn league night points will be used to break the tie.

Should a match be tied after the completion of 9 holes then the teams will continue back to their starting hole with strokes remaining the same. The match will be played out in sudden death. Once a team has won a hole, they will have been considered to win the match. No Substitutes will be allowed to play for a team member during the one-night tournament unless a medical issue occurs with one of the team members. In this situation prior approval must be obtained before the Tournament. If your team did not make the top 8 spots in your division then you will be entered to play in the fun-night tournament. This will be no additional cost to the player and there will be prizes awarded to the winners.

If the scheduled Tournament Date and Fun Night are rained out, it will be rescheduled for the following week.

SCHEDULED TIMES/RULES

Times will be posted by the first week of qualifying for each team's arrival. Please check the player rosters to see your opponent's arrival time. There will be a 10-minute grace period allowed for being later then your scheduled time. If you are going to be late for any reasons call the Pro Shop so they may notify your opponents. The opponents may elect to play if the 10 minutes has surpassed regardless of whether or not you have called. If this is the case, then you may still "catch up" to them and continue playing out the rest of the holes. You must start on the next tee from the hole they are currently playing. You will have lost whatever holes that they have completed

STANDINGS

Results will be posted each week to inform everyone as to the standings. Match results must be handed in to the Scorer each week. <u>Failure to hand in a score card with will</u> result in no points awarded.

LEAGUE HANDICAPS

The first week of league will be used for coming up with the first average. For prior year members: your average at the end of last year will be averaged with you first week qualifying score. If you are a new player and do not have a GHIN handicap, then we will use your practice round score with any other scoring information that is given to come up with a starting average. Once an average has been established each player will be subject to a maximum posting for league average of double the par on a hole. For example, 8 on par 4, 6 on a par 3.

Averages will be updated and calculated weekly.

GOLD TEES

Players aged 70 and above have the option of playing the gold tees. If you wish to play the gold tees a decision must be made before the first day of league. If a player wishes to play the gold tees you must play those tees for the remainder of the league schedule and if applicable the Tournament.

STROKES

Players will stroke off the player with the lowest average in the foursome. Players receiving strokes will get 50% of the difference between averages. Score cards will be marked and stroked by the league Director and can be picked up in the Pro Shop. The maximum number of strokes any one player can receive is nine.

SCHEDULE

Matches will be played on Tuesday evenings. The tee will be reserved from 3:30 p.m. to 5:15p.m. The tee will be on a first come/first serve basis. Divisions will alternate from front nine to back nine each week and will be posted on your schedule!

A schedule of matches will be posted on the bulletin board outside the lounge and on our webpage. A list of participants with phone numbers will also be posted. It will be up to the teams to contact their opponents about a compatible tee time. If a match is a washout, it will not be rescheduled unless otherwise determined by the League Committee. **All matches must finish in order for it to be considered an official league night.**

RAIN-OUT POLICY

A rain-check will be given to any player who has not finished 5 holes of a round. If a player has finished 5 or more holes then a rain-check will not be issued.
