## WASHINGTON STATE FALLEN FIREFIGHTER FOUNDATION:

The Washington State Fallen Firefighter Memorial Foundation was founded to develop a Fallen Firefighter Memorial where we can etch the names of our fallen firefighters in stone on the campus of the State capital. Since 1891 there have been 255 firefighter that have died in the line of duty in the state of Washington. The WSFFF works in conjunction with the Washington State Local Assistant Team (LAST) which is a program of the National Fallen Firefighters Foundation and we work with a department after the death of a firefighter to plan and do the funeral service. WA LAST is the equivalent of Behind the Badge for the Fire Service. We have assisted all types of firefighter deaths, retirees, active duty, and line of duty for both career and volunteer firefighters. We work with the WA State Firefighters' Association, the WA State Council of Firefighters, the WA State Fire Chiefs Association and the WA State Fire Marshal's Office to make sure the proper honors are being given for the situation. The money we raise goes directly to supporting the work of the LAST team and to the planning of the memorial.

## BEHIND THE BADGE FOUNDATION:

The mission of Behind the Badge Foundation is to honor law enforcement officers who have died or suffered serious injury in the line of duty. We serve as a trusted resource, providing immediate and ongoing support to families, agencies and communities in times of critical need. We also maintain the Washington State Law Enforcement Memorial, commemorating the lives and dedication of officers who have died in service to our state.

Behind the Badge Foundation provides comprehensive support to Washington State's law enforcement agencies, families and communities after an officer has died or suffered serious injury in the line of duty. Behind the Badge Foundation serves survivors of a line of duty death. (Spouses, children, parents, siblings, significant others, in-laws, affected co-workers and chaplains.) Behind the Badge also serves law enforcement officers who continue to serve and protect our communities, and their families.
