

Men's League - 2022



SCHEDULE & FORMAT

- **All scores are adjusted by your handicap**
- **Stableford - Weeks 1-6 (May 17th to June 21st)**
 - See format details below
- **Matchplay - Weeks 7-15 (June 28th to August 30th *No league on 7/5*)**
 - 2 Points for winning the hole
 - 1 Point for tying the hole
 - 0 Points for losing the hole
 - No more than 9 strokes can be given/received in a single match.
- **Playoffs - Week 16 (September 6th)**
 - Matchplay

COURSE RULES

- USGA Rules apply
- Lift Clean and Place
 - Your own FAIRWAY ONLY. One club length, no closer to the hole.
- Drainage Ditch on Holes 12 & 13
 - Free drop if your ball or stance is in the ditch.

MISCELLANEOUS

- **NEW: All players are responsible for coordinating their substitutes. Your two options are;**
 - 1. Contact Jason Greiner and ask him to find a sub
 - 2. Find your own sub and inform Jason of the switch. Please note the sub's handicap
- **All sub notices and requests must be sent BEFORE Tuesday's round.**
 - Players who do not contact Jason are subject to 0 points.

- **Weather Cancellation: You will be notified before 2:30 p.m. on the day of League if it is canceled.**

- Mid-Round Weather: All 4 players in a group must agree to split points if the weather is too dangerous to play in.
- Players under the age of 70 must play from the **WHITE** tee's. Players 70+ have the option to play from the **RED** tee's.
- Scorecards will be prepared by Dave Richeidei on Tuesday afternoons. You can pick them up on the patio before your round and drop them off in the basket afterwards.
- Handicaps: Each players 9 holes score will be recorded weekly to adjust their appropriate handicap based on the USGA Formula ((Average score - 33.3)*113) / 130
- League Dues: \$45 per player (Includes 2 Catered Dinners and Cash Prizes)

PACE OF PLAY

- Maximum Stroke Limit: Every player must pick up their ball if their score exceeds 3 over par for that given hole regardless of their **handicap or opponent**.
 - Once a player reaches the maximum stroke limit they **MUST** pick up their ball on that hole. In Match Play, picking up your ball means you concede the hole and receive 0 points for the hole.
 - **Example: Player 1 and Player 2 are competing on a par 4. Player 1 hits his 7th shot into the bunker. Player 1 must pick up his ball. Player 2 continues to play the hole and also receives a 7. Player 2 wins the hole because Player 1 conceded first.**
 - **Everyone is encouraged, but not required, to pick up their ball after their opponent concedes to speed up the pace of play.**

NOTES

- Matchplay Format: Players who do not find themselves a sub or do not compete in their scheduled match will receive 0 points for that week.
 - **Their scheduled opponent will play Stableford instead of receiving the full 18 points. The points received that night will go towards their team's final score.**

SCORECARD EXAMPLE: STABLEFORD

- **Stableford - Weeks 1-6 (May 17th to June 21st)**

- 2 Points for a net birdie or better
- 1 point for a net par
- 0 points for a net bogey or worse
- A total of 18 Points are available in each round.
- Strokes are given based on the player's 9 hole handicap.

Example Stableford Scorecard (*=Stroke hole)

Each hole's "Handicap" represents its difficulty in relation to the course. The lower the number means the more difficult the hole. Colin received 1 stroke on the 7 hardest holes (lowest numbers)

SCORECARD EXAMPLE: MATCHPLAY

- **Matchplay - Weeks 7-15 (June 28th to August 30st)**

- 2 Points for winning the hole
- 1 point for tying the hole
- 0 points for the loss of a hole
- A total of 18 Points are available in each match. 36 Total points per foursome
- Each team's lowest handicap players vs each other. Each team's highest handicap player vs each other.
- Strokes are awarded to the player with the higher handicap in the amount of the difference between the two opponents.

- **Matchplay Strokes: No more than 1 stroke can be awarded on a single hole regardless of handicap.**
