TURF TALK

As the bermudagrass emerges from dormancy, we will begin to fertilize and aerate tee tops and fairways. It appears that we have experienced some spring dead spot but these areas should recover quickly with fertilization and warmer temperatures.

Greens are healing nicely from a recent verticutting and topdressing. Fertilizer and micronutrients have also been applied to optimize the spring growing season. Annual soil and water testing has been performed to help us tailor our agronomic programs for the season.

Course amenities have also been installed on the course. These include, refurbished ball -washers and water cooler stations, 150 yard marker poles, cart directional signage, new trash cans and several new driving range mats. Club house signage, cart barn trim and scoreboard painting will take place as soon as conditions permit. Looking forward to seeing you more often as the weather improves!

90 Degree Cart Rule: Important (please read)

At this time of the year, it is **extremely important** to enter the fairways at 90 degrees to the ball from the path in order to help not wear out the turf at the beginning of each fairway once leaving the tee box. We are noticing an abundance of wear in these areas and we want to avoid putting up ropes/signs in order to keep carts from damaging the turf further. Your help and attention to this matter

is most appreciated
