Turf Talk October 24, 2022

An early bout of cooler than normal temperatures has slowed the growth of our bermudagrass noticeably. Our first frost was actually on October 6th! This reduction in growth results in fewer mowings per week and more time to blow leaves. On that note, I hope we have a decent foliage display this year. Beneficial rain in early fall should help to provide some decent fall color.

Agronomically the course is all set to battle the cooler winter weather. Fertilizer was applied to most of the course in early fall that will help the Bermuda harden off. The greens continue to improve from our brutal late summer weather. A few spots remain that will be topdressed and fertilized to ensure coverage prior to the winter months. We are having a mole issue on a couple of holes this fall, most notably 9 green. We have treated the area several times and will continue to work to eradicate these pests.

If you see a contraption beside a green or tee don't be alarmed, you'll know what it's for! As we move into cooler fall weather and the dreaded occasional frost delay, we look forward to seeing you on the course!
