**Description of Player Club Program 18-Hole PC & 9-Hole PC**

-Must email [JRJGC2021@gmail.com](mailto:JRJGC2021@gmail.com) (EMAIL ONLY SIGNUPS) listing the junior's name, clinics and play division (18 or 9 holes) no later than Friday by 3pm the week of the event to sign up. **NO LATE SIGNUPS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Juniors will play 18 or 9-hole competitions throughout the season. All PLAYERS/Jr. Club Members have the option to purchase a 90-day pass for \$125. This pass is good any day of the week, with the exception of playing after 12pm on weekends and Holidays – Juniors without the 90-day pass will pay \$10 per event for competition. 9-hole players will pay \$8 per event. All MAJOR events (notated by an \* on the schedule) are events that **must be paid in advance.** All Majors will cost \$15 (for those holding a 90-day pass) and \$35 (for those without). Juniors can get a signup form at either golf course for these events (two weeks prior). All juniors in this club will need to post their scores on GHIN.com or through the GHIN APP (Golf Handicap & Information Network) – if the junior is not able to complete this process the pro shop staff may be able to assist. YOC memberships are not able to be used for Joe Richer PC days.

All juniors and/or parents are responsible for looking in their email or contacting the pro shop after 5:00pm for the current week's tee times. We cannot guarantee that a junior will play with their friends for each event. Students will be assigned specific tees, and are paired in flights according to their playing ability (decided by the golf professional). All Players Club Juniors should attend the clinic starting at 10am (if applicable), When we feel a junior from the 9-hole division has a good understanding of the rules, golf etiquette, pace of play and has advanced enough to play in 18-hole competition then they may be moved up into the 18-hole Players Club.

**Description of Players in Training Program**

-Must email [JRJGC2021@gmail.com](mailto:JRJGC2021@gmail.com) (**EMAIL ONLY SIGNUPS**) listing the junior's name and clinic they will attend (*9am -ages 8-14 & 10:30am - ages 12-18*) no later than Friday (the week prior) by 3pm...**NO LATE SIGNUPS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Bring your own clubs if you have them or contact the staff if the junior does not have clubs, so we can be prepared to provide them. Please show up at least 10 minutes early. Juniors will sign up by time slot according to age (with some exceptions), and availability is based on a first-come first-serve basis (signing up by email). A junior may request to join their friends when signing up, as long as space is available, and we may accommodate their request.

Our goal is to have juniors in the Players in Training program move their way into the Players Club program as fast as possible. We will move juniors up when the professional staff feels that they are ready to get out onto the golf course. If you feel your Junior is close/ready, let a professional staff know.

FAMILY GOLF NIGHT for the PIT students and family members is a lot of fun! We would like to see each junior come out for a night out on the course with an adult (parent or friend) and play 4 holes on our normal 18-hole golf course. Cost for the 4-hole play will be \$5 per person. Please see schedule for dates and times.

Once the \$40 membership is paid, there is no additional cost for any clinics offered for PIT.

**\*\*COVID-19—JRJGC students will be required to wear masks in group gatherings and when in the buildings. Playing golf on the course, masks are not required by JRJGC rules/regulations. Most instruction settings will require masks to be worn. Due to COVID, events may be cancelled with very little notice. No refunds will be given on membership once the “season starts” at the end of June.**

## **JOE RICHER JUNIOR GOLF CODE OF CONDUCT AND RULES**

The Joe Richer Junior Golf Club provides a worthwhile activity, which can be pursued throughout life and helps develop character and good sportsmanship. All JRJGC competitions are conducted under the USGA Rules of Golf, as amended by the local rules. In addition, the following is a Code of Conduct, which is a guideline of junior golfers to follow throughout the tournaments, both on and off the course. It is not intended to intimidate players, but to help JRJGC members to understand the consequences of their actions.

- 1. USE DECENT AND PROPER LANGUAGE AND BEHAVIOR AT ALL TIMES**
  - a. UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT EXAMPLES: Cheating, unreported violation of a USGA Rule of Golf, swearing, obscene vulgar language or gestures, throwing clubs, displaying poor attitude, behavior or conduct.
  - b. PROHIBITED USE: Smoking, or use of tobacco or chewing tobacco, alcohol or drugs.
- 2. RESPECT AND CARE FOR THE PROPERTY OF OTHERS AND THE GOLF COURSE**
  - a. PROPER EXAMPLES: Replace divots, repair ball marks, rake bunkers and use proper containers for garbage.
  - b. IMPROPER EXAMPLES: Damaging greens, defacing or destroying club property, littering, leaving divots or ball marks, failure to rake bunkers, etc.
- 3. GOLF ATTIRE FOR BOYS AND GIRLS**
  - a. PROPER ATTIRE: Neat and clean clothing, shoes, mid-thigh length golf style shorts, skirts or long pants. All caps must be worn bill-forward, and shirts must be tucked in.
  - b. IMPROPER ATTIRE: Tennis or short shorts, tank tops, cut-offs, sweats, spandex and halter-tops.
- 4. ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE PROHIBITED FOR USE ON COURSE**
  - a. PROHIBITED DEVICES INCLUDE: Cellular phones, noise making pagers, radios, Walkman and/or other similar noise-making devices.

### **PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF CODE OF CONDUCT:**

First Infraction:	Warning
Second Infraction:	Disqualification – can play in next event.
Third Infraction:	Disqualification from current event and following event.
Fourth Infraction:	Disqualification for the remainder of season
<i>Note:</i>	<i>Disqualification can preempt warning if violation is flagrant</i>

1. Motorized carts are not permitted. Pull carts are allowed. Caddies would need to check and be cleared for approval by the host Golf Professional after a briefing of caddie responsibilities. Caddies would then need to introduce themselves to the Starter for final clearance. A caddie must be at least 15 years of age and not a parent/grandparent.
2. Picking-Up (quitting) without permission before play has ended will result in disqualification and suspension from the next event.
3. Players must register for the current week event by 3pm on Friday before (previous week) otherwise there is **no guaranteed entry** into the event. We must get signups the week prior so we can ensure that we have enough staff members onsite. Withdrawals may be made at least 24 hours prior to an event with notice given to the staff.
4. No-shows with less than 24 hours notice will result in suspension from next event (case by case basis).
5. Players may be penalized for slow play if more than one hole is open ahead of the group OR if not completing a set of holes in a time specified by the Rules Committee. A player may be subject to penalty if observed to require in excess of 40 seconds each for two separate shots. To keep playing moving, no extra hits/putts throughout the round.
6. Galleries (including parents) must keep a distance of 25 yards from the players and should walk in the rough\* (not in play). Please also be aware of the groups behind you. No coaching or advice is allowed. The first infraction will result in a warning to the spectator. The spectator will be asked to leave the course if there is a second infraction. If the spectator refuses to leave, the player may be disqualified. The player is responsible for the actions of family & friends in the gallery. Helping kids is no problem, coaching/advice is a problem.
7. After players have left the attesting table, cards are officially turned into the Committee and no changes may be made.

### **How to sign up for a PIT or Players Club event and why**

You can email the golf shop beginning Tuesday before the week's event; the last day to take signups will be 3pm Friday before the event (the week before). – This needs to be done so we can staff instructors accordingly and make accurate pairings. – To sign up, you may email [JRIGC2021@gmail.com](mailto:JRIGC2021@gmail.com) (email signups only for 2021, if this is an issue, please call General Manager Shayne Day at 425-610-2070). – When signing up for the weekly Players in Training (PIT) please give the juniors name, age, clinic date, and if Player Club (PC) please give number of holes playing (9 or 18) and their preferred tee box. **EMAIL IS THE ONLY WAY TO SIGN UP FOR 2021**

**All Joe Richer Juniors must abide by the USGA rules of golf and the Joe Richer Code of Conduct. Any junior not abiding by the rules may be suspended or removed from the junior club without question.**
