

## • Is the Joe Richer Club still active?

- Yes, the club is still active. We have recently partnered with the First Tee of Greater Seattle. The First Tee and their team will run the Players in Training program. The Professional staff at Legion and Walter Hall will run the Players Club program.
- My junior is just learning how to play the game, what is the best option for him/her?
  - Juniors that are just learning the game should join the Joe Richer/First Tee program. Signups are online with the first tee program. Please visit <u>https://firstteeseattle.org/programs/register/</u>
- How much does it cost to join the JRJGC (Players Club)
  - The cost is \$40 to join. Please fill out an application and drop check in the mail or stop by the pro shop and sign up.
- What if my junior understands the game and plays just a little bit, should they register with the First Tee/Players in Training (PIT) or the Players Club (PC) at the courses?
  - This is one of the big reasons why we partnered with the First Tee. Juniors can now do both. If your Junior needs more focus on the training, I highly recommend they do both or just the PIT for now. In order to do the PC, the juniors need to be able to play an unsupervised 9 or 18 holes in a timely manner and have a general understanding of the game and the rules.
- Do you have a 9 hole PC and an 18 hole PC
  - Yes, we do have a 9-hole Players Club as well as an 18-hole Players Club. The 9-hole students are generally kids that are just learning or haven't played much on the course. Usually, our 18-hole PC kids tee off around 11am and then the 9-hole PC kids tee off right after them.
- Do the PC kids get instruction?
  - Yes, before each weekly event we do an hour-long clinic (generally at 10am) prior to the kids teeing off at 11am for 18-holes PC club and around 11:30/12 for the 9-hole PC. We change the aspect of the clinics we are doing weekly.
- How much is it each week to play in Players Club events?
  - Starting in 2022, we will only be charging \$5 per junior (doesn't matter if its 9-hole PC or 18-hole PC).
- What day of the week do Players Club kids play?
  - 95% of our events are on Wednesdays. We have some two-day events and those are usually Tue/Wed or Wed/Thu. Schedule will be out around the end of May. We usually start the week kids get out of school.
- What do the PC kids win if they win their "flight"?
  - Generally juniors are winning sleeves or dozens of balls, hats, tees, polos from the host course pro shop.
- How would my junior sign up for the weekly competitions for the Players Club?
  - We are going to do our signups now through Golf Genius. 10 days prior to that week's event, Golf Genius will send out an automated email asking you if you are playing. Simply click playing and that will notify us that you intend on playing for that week. You will have until the Monday prior to the event (9am). If the junior cannot play, simply click not playing and the system won't keep emailing you to invite.
