Description of Player Club Program 18-Hole PC & 9-Hole PC

-Weekly competitions for *Juniors who can play an unsupervised nine or eighteen holes of golf in a proficient and timely manner*. Juniors will compete against other Juniors based on age/tee color and or ability. Juniors will compete weekly to win prizes from the host course pro shop. New for 2023, we will have all signups for our weekly competitions available online (via email) using Golf Genius. The Golf Genius system will email all PC juniors 10days prior to the next event date. To play for that week's competition, simply click playing. **NO LATE SIGN UPS WILL BE ACCEPTED**. Juniors will play 18 or 9-hole competitions throughout the season. All PLAYERS/Jr. Club Members have the option to purchase a 90-day pass for \$125. This pass is good Monday through Friday anytime and weekends after 12pm. – Juniors without the 90-day pass will pay \$5 per event for competition (including 9 hole PC and 18 hole PC). MAJOR events (notated by an * on the schedule) are events that **must be paid in advance**. All Majors will cost \$15 (for those holding a 90-day pass) and \$30 (for those without). Juniors can get a signup form at either golf course for these events (two weeks prior). All juniors in this club will need to post their scores on GHIN.com or through the GHIN APP (Golf Handicap & Information Network) – if the junior is not able to complete this process the pro shop staff may be able to assist. YOC memberships are **not** able to be used for Joe Richer PC days.

All juniors and/or parents are responsible for looking in their email and signing up the juniors weekly. We cannot guarantee that a junior will play with their friends for each event. Students will be assigned specific tees and are paired in flights according to their playing ability (decided by the golf professional). All Players Club Juniors should attend the clinic starting at 10am (if applicable), When we feel a junior from the 9-hole division has a good understanding of the rules, golf etiquette, pace of play and has advanced enough to play in 18-hole competition then they may be moved up into the 18-hole Players Club.

Description of Players in Training Program

-The Joe Richer Junior Club has partnered with the First Tee program to run our PIT (Players in Training program). The golf course staff will no longer be responsible for PIT portion of the Joe Richer Club. Please signup online at www.firstteeseattle.org/programs/ to register for the 2022 PIT programs at Legion or Walter Hall. The Joe Richer First Tee program will be on Tuesdays at Walter Hall (starting July 5th) and Thursdays (starting July 7th at Legion Memorial. Please sign up online at www.firstteeseattle.org/programs/. Do not wait to sign up online for the Joe Richer First Tee clinics, space is limited.

JOE RICHER JUNIOR GOLF CODE OF CONDUCT AND RULES

The Joe Richer Junior Golf Club provides a worthwhile activity, which can be pursued throughout life and helps develop character and good sportsmanship. All JRJGC competitions are conducted under the USGA Rules of Golf, as amended by the local rules. In addition, the following is a Code of Conduct, which is a guideline of junior golfers to follow throughout the tournaments, both on and off the course. It is not intended to intimidate players, but to help JRJGC members to understand the consequences of their actions.

- 1. USE DECENT AND PROPER LANGUAGE AND BEHAVIOR AT ALL TIMES**
 - a. UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT EXAMPLES: Cheating, unreported violation of a USGA Rule of Golf, swearing, obscene vulgar language or gestures, throwing clubs, displaying poor attitude, behavior or conduct.
 - b. PROHIBITED USE: Smoking, or use of tobacco or chewing tobacco, alcohol or drugs.
- 2. RESPECT AND CARE FOR THE PROPERTY OF OTHERS AND THE GOLF COURSE**
 - a. PROPER EXAMPLES: Replace divots, repair ball marks, rake bunkers and use proper containers for garbage.
 - b. IMPROPER EXAMPLES: Damaging greens, defacing or destroying club property, littering, leaving divots or ball marks, failure to rake bunkers, etc.
- 3. GOLF ATTIRE FOR BOYS AND GIRLS**
 - a. PROPER ATTIRE: Neat and clean clothing, shoes, mid-thigh length golf style shorts, skirts or long pants. All caps must be worn bill-forward, and shirts must be tucked in.
 - b. IMPROPER ATTIRE: Tennis or short shorts, tank tops, cut-offs, sweats, spandex and halter-tops.
- 4. ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE PROHIBITED FOR USE ON COURSE**
 - a. PROHIBITED DEVICES INCLUDE: Cellular phones, noise making pagers, radios, Walkman and/or other similar noise-making devices.

PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF CODE OF CONDUCT:

First Infraction:	Warning
Second Infraction:	Disqualification – can play in next event.
Third Infraction:	Disqualification from current event and following event.
Fourth Infraction:	Disqualification for the remainder of season
Note:	<i>Disqualification can preempt warning if violation is fragrant</i>

1. Motorized carts are not permitted. Pull carts are allowed. Caddies would need to check and be cleared for approval by the host Golf Professional after a briefing of caddie responsibilities. Caddies would then need to introduce themselves to the Starter for final clearance. A caddie must be at least 15 years of age and not a parent/grandparent.
2. Picking-Up (quitting) without permission before play has ended will result in disqualification and suspension from the next event.
3. Players must register for the current week event by 9am the Monday Prior, otherwise there is **no guaranteed entry** into the event. Withdrawals may be made at least 24 hours prior to an event with notice given to the staff.
4. No-shows with less than 24 hours' notice will result in suspension from next event (case by case basis).
5. Players may be penalized for slow play if more than one hole is open ahead of the group OR if not completing a set of holes in a time specified by the Rules Committee. A player may be subject to penalty if observed to require in excess of 40 seconds each for two separate shots. To keep playing moving, no extra hits/putts throughout the round.
6. Galleries (including parents) must keep a distance of 25 yards from the players and should walk in the rough* (not in play). Please also be aware of the groups behind you. No coaching or advice is allowed. The first infraction will result in a warning to the spectator. The spectator will be asked to leave the course if there is a second infraction. If the spectator refuses to leave, the player may be disqualified. The player is responsible for the actions of family & friends in the gallery. Helping kids is no problem, coaching/advice is a problem.
7. After players have left the attesting table, cards are officially turned into the Committee and no changes may be made.

How to sign up for a Players Club event and why

10days prior to the next competition, we will generate an email requesting you to sign up for the competition (sent via Golf Genius). We will cut off signups the Monday prior to that week's competition (9am). When you receive this email, simply click on playing and that will put the Junior in for that week's event. If you know your Junior cannot play, simply click not playing and the system won't keep asking you to sign up. We cut off the signups approximately 3 days prior so we can make sure we have enough staff to help with the Junior event that week. Late additions will be very difficult. Please make sure you click playing each week that you intend to play.

All Joe Richer Juniors must abide by the USGA rules of golf and the Joe Richer Code of Conduct. Any junior not abiding by the rules may be suspended or removed from the junior club without question.
