By the City of New Haven ordinance, the following definitions apply:

TO QUALIFY AS A RESIDENT: You must be a resident of the City of New Haven or a resident of the Town of East Haven. Proper identification is required in the form of a valid driver’s license and a current residential real estate tax bill to verify residency. Three additional forms of identification may be required for those individuals who do not have a valid driver’s license or residential real estate tax bill.

SENIOR: Is defined as any individual who is sixty-two years of age or older.

JUNIOR: Is defined as any individual who is seventeen years of age or younger.

FAMILY MEMBERSHIP: Limited to father and/or mother and any children seventeen years of age or younger within the same family.
