Canyon Lakes Golf Course Tee Time Policy

TEE TIME AVAILABILITY AT CANYON LAKES.

We want Canyon Lakes Golf Course to have a strong golf membership but also be more available for public play. As a result, there will be a new policy to open our tee sheet up for more public play.

Members will be able to

reserve tee times Monday through Thursday 10 days in advance. There will be a change Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM as non-members will have 14 days in advance to reserve tee times and members will have 3 days in advance during the 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM slots.

We will continue to work with

members to make sure no times go unused. Members will have the ability to reserve tee times 10 days in advance for all other tee times Monday through Thursday and on Friday, Saturday and Sunday not between 9:00 AM and 12:00 PM.

All this will take effect on January 1, 2025. Nothing changes this year.
