### Until Daylight Savings (11/6) we will still be running an individual stroke play competition on Wed & Sat. Starting 11/6 we will switch to the formats below. Weekly Format (Sun-Sat)

There will be a weekly competition similar to our Wednesday League, the only difference is you can play on any day of the week from Sun-Sat. Odds are there will be different course set ups & different weather for each day so choose wisely if you can. At the end of each week we will figure out the results. If you play bad and you want to try again you can buy back in once but it will cost you double for all games. On some days the weekly & weekend competitions may overlap but you can only play in one at a time. Play will be mostly from the white tees but may vary. Seniors 60+ can move up a set of tees but will lose handicap strokes & not be eligible for the gross payout.

### Weekend Formats (Play Sat or Sun, Tees Will Vary)

Each weekend we will have a different format which will be posted at least 1 week in advance. You can compete on either day (except for the majors) as the tees & pins should be the same for both days.

# \$6,000 Frostbite League Finale & Huge Skins Pot!

Our FBL Finale will be a combination of 2 events including a 2 person best ball & individual stroke play (\$3,000 payout ea.). To be eligible for the event you must be a North Bellingham Member. Entry fee will be based on points list position! There will be at least \$500 in added cash to the Skins Pot! Skins will be individual only & cost will be based on points list position.

**Earnings Points** 

### Players will earn 100 participation points for each competition played. <u>Frostbite League Schedule</u>

(subject to change & will be updated as we move through the season)

**11/20-11/25:** Individual Stroke Play/White Tees.

### 11/26: Two Man Tip & Turkey. This is an FBL Major, see separate entry for details.

11/27-12/3: Individual Stroke Play/Gold Tees.

**12/3-12/4:** Individual Stableford Football Edition/White Tees. Players will get points based on their scores. Eagle=Touchdown(6), Birdie=Field Goal(3), Par=Safety(2), Bogey=Extra Point(1)

**12/4-12/10:** Individual Stroke Play/White Tees.

**12/10-12/11:** 3 Person CHA CHA/CHA/White Tees. 3 person teams will play a modified best ball format counting 1 ball on the first hole, 2 balls on the second, and all 3 balls on the third. This process is then repeated every 3 holes until the round is completed.

12/11-12/17: Individual Stroke Play/Blue Tees.

**12/17-12/18:** 2 Man Scramble/Red Tees. 6 drives & second shots pp. 25% of combined hdcp.

12/18-12/23: Individual Stroke Play/Gold Tees.

**12/24:** 2 Person Chapman/White Tees. Players will hit their partner's tee shot. After 2 shots have been played on each ball take one out of play and alternate on the other ball until holed. 40% of combined handicap will be used for net scoring.

**12/26-12/31:** Individual Stroke Play/White Tees.

#### 12/31: Holiday 3-4-5-6 Tourney. This is an FBL Major, see separate entry for details.

**1/1-1/7:** Individual Stroke Play/Red Tees.

**1/7-1/8:** Drive for Show, Putt for Dough, & Learn how to Throw/White Tees. Players will only get to use 3 clubs for this one (driver, putter, and an iron of your choice) however, you will have the **OPTION** of using your arm to throw the ball once inside of 100 yards on each hole (must be off the green). This will count as a stroke of course & you must release the ball before stepping past where it lied.

**1/8-1/14:** Individual Stroke Play/White Tees.

#### 1/14: One Person Scramble Bank Mode. This is an FBL Major, see separate entry for details.

**1/15-1/21:** Individual Stroke Play/Gold Tees.

**1/21-1/22:** Individual Mulligan Tourney/Blue Tees. Players will get a number of mulligans equal to their course handicap that they can use anywhere on the course. If used the mulligan must be played (no going back to 1<sup>st</sup> ball). Players will get 50% handicap for net scoring.

**1/22-1/28:** Individual Stroke Play/White Tees.
