It's hard to believe that it has been a year since the transition. After a year we are grateful for many things. The membership has been very patient during the year. And with Surf N Turf nights it has shown the membership truly cares about the future. When we started this adventure the amount of fruit that was low hanging was immense. Being that we were entering fall and winter there were many of those that could not be focused upon because of dormant grass season approaching. The dry winter and spring also exasperated our attempts to kill and eliminate weeds with an inferior irrigation system at that time.

Last December we outlined our plan of attack in regaining control of the poor conditions from years of neglect. The first phase was to concentrate on areas "in play"; specifically greens, fairways and tees. Next came the roughs and trees. The third phase is coming soon once the grasses go dormant once again.

Winter months will allow us to start much of the detail work still needed. Bunkers, woods, cart path demolitions and more. We will not be overseeding any turf areas this year. The turf stands we have started training are not strong enough yet to handle a transition in the spring. The new turf on the driving range is still in infancy in digging deeper roots. We will be dying fairways, tees and greens for visibility and aesthetics.

We need your help during the winter months — honestly it would be great to get your help all year, but especially in the colder months. All golfers can help by:

- 1. Fixing any ball mark you see
- 2. Pour sand into all divots. Bare areas are weed nurseries when bare.
- 3. Use the rough for travel as much as possible to reduce compaction.
- 4. Practice tee use "divot striping" method to help recovery in spring

Thanks again for your hep. We are well on our way to once again being a course standard as "best in class".
