Unionville Vineyards was recently awarded a Double Gold at the International Eastern Wine Competition for their Hunter's Red Reserve 2002, Meritage. This wine, which is a blend of Cabernet Franc 51%, Cabernet Sauvignon 44% and Merlot 5% is sweeping up additional medals throughout the country, with Gold at the Tasters Guild International Wine Judging, Silver at the Finger Lakes International Wine Competition as well as the New Jersey Wine Competition 2004.

The Ringoes vineyard took the governor's cup, the top award in the 17th annual New Jersey Wine Competition last month. Unionville won for its 2000 Nielsen Estate Proprietor's Reserve, which also took a gold medal as best vinifera in the competition.
