Here's to hoping that your holiday season has been joyous and memorable! As 2014 winds down the following facts and figures should be shared so the membership can see what your Club did this year:

- Rounds of golf played at DDCC increased by over 4,000 (33%) from 2013.
- The course hosted a total of 20 non-member golf outings which provide additional revenue.
- Golf Event participation showed another strong year with an extended field for Invitational and Men's League.
- Renovation to the patio was completed adding a unique feature to our Club that is not equaled anywhere in the area. The member response and utilization has been incredible.
- The number of fitness classes was increased and the scheduled days & times expanded.
- Membership numbers increased in 2014 by about 9%.
- The course opened to a full 18 holes. The Palmer redesigned 17th and 18th complement the existing layout. Remediation of the various ponds on the course is complete and has returned the vistas to the original design.
- Last, but definitely not least, service has been a struggle all year as we transitioned through several food and beverage managers. Adding to the scenario was the difficulty with staffing due to low unemployment in the area.

All things considered 2014 was a productive and successful year for your Club. In 2015, the focus will be on service, service, service and improved quality across the board. Expect expanded activities, live music on the patio and new offerings. We need to strengthen the membership base and welcome new members. Watch for the announcements as club management finalizes plans for 2015. I am sure that the membership won't be disappointed.

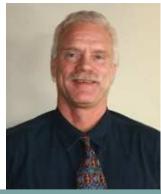

.69" of rain on the fifteenth of December is without a doubt the best Christmas present ever for Dakota Dunes. (Particularly after the winter of 2013 through 2014.) Normal winter temperatures followed the rain, sealing in and freezing a healthy turf.

The temperate December allowed us to get a head start on working on the tree canopy. Currently, our priority with tree work has been on hole nine. Our objective is two-fold: to be able to play golf and to allow sunlight to improve the playability and agronomics. Hopefully the winter season will allow us to have the stumps ground so when spring arrives we can fill the holes and seed them back to playable rough. When weather does not allow us to proceed with this worthwhile endeavor, the winter over haul addressing the equipment fleets takes precedence.

Our priority for 2015 is going to be green speeds. Believe it or not tree work will have a very large effect on green speeds. There is a very long list of agronomic issues which affect playability on the greens as well as throughout the golf course. One has to be very flexible when addressing green speeds. Obviously a cool, wet year while in the middle of a grow-in creates a different set of circumstances than a hot, humid, dry year does. We are going to change cultural practices as the weather patterns dictate. Whatever cannot be accomplished on a Monday will be carried out into the early morning hours the following Tuesday with the least bother to the member.

2015 is shaping up to another great year as our calendars are quickly filling up with events throughout the year. We look forward to making 2015 a successful year out on the golf course and wish you and your families a Happy New Year.
