Superintendent's Corner

From the course:

Reality check! Another long winter in Northeast Ohio, yet we boldly predict there will be better days ahead. We have a head start on cleaning up the course. It is amazing how much clean up is required after winter. The winter storms create a number of broken branches, limbs, twigs and miscellaneous debris that needs to be picked up before we start mowing. The good news is there are better days ahead and the staff and I are anxious to get the course in fine shape for an outstanding golfing season.

Despite the past winter weather, overall, the course came through in good shape. This winter snow took longer to melt versus last winter. We didn't get a January thaw, and the snow continued to accumulate as much as two feet of packed snow. The snow caused more snow mold than usual and mainly occurred in the rough. It is caused by the grass blades being smashed down on the surface. The grass blades block off any air movement to the soil, creating a nice incubator for the mold spores to grow and flourish. This is a natural and common occurrence, however, and will cure itself as the grass starts to grow.

The range will be opening in mid April, and we will start hitting on the synthetic mat. When the soil temperatures warm up enough to allow seed germination, we will open up the turf area. Our goal is to provide a quality hitting surface throughout the year. FYI, it takes a minimum of 45 days for the seed to mature and be ready to hit off of again. Our rotation of the stations is based on allowing the time needed for the seed to mature. Sometimes it requires more time depending on growing conditions. There is something everyone can do to help keep our range the best in Ohio. That is accomplished by limiting the amount of divots. There is a helpful way to hit range balls on a tee and is detailed in Page 4 of this Newsletter.

Lastly, I would like to announce the hiring of William (Clay) Crosley as our Assistant Superintendent. William goes by Clay. He will be a valuable asset in assisting our team in taking StoneWater to a higher level. He brings years of private club experience from quality golf course maintenance operations. His experience includes Country Club, Oakwood Club, Firestone CC, Shaker CC and Canterbury Golf Club. Clay brings leadership and the commitment to continue to improve our course conditions and enjoyment!

I've been asked numerous times by parents if they should come to their kid's lessons. This is really an individual preference and can lead to a positive environment if treated correctly.

For the parent's that want to help their kids I recommend that they come to all lessons and listen carefully and take notes. I personally invite them to sit in a chair on the lesson tee and view the lesson and at the same time make sure they understand the process. This is an opportunity to let the student know the parent, teacher and the student are all on the same page. I also explain that this is the triangle of learning and it speeds up the learning process. "Just think of it, now the student has two coaches and they both are telling me the same thing."

Then again, we run into the student that doesn't want his parents around and also the parents don't want to be viewing the lesson. In this particular situation I make sure the pupil has all of his or her homework written on a piece of paper of which I have a copy.

I have always felt that this can be a very positive moment for the teacher, the parent and the student.



Driving Range Care

Continued from Golf Course Superintendent– Steve Ambrose

The following method is how I was instructed to hit balls off the range tee:

Place the ball at the most forward location of the hitting area. After the first divot, place the next ball as close to the middle back edge of the divot. There should not be more than a half an inch of turf between the ball and previous divot. Continue straight back for about a foot using this method. Then move back to the front divot and place the ball as close to the left edge of the first divot of the first row. Then continue the same method used on the first row. Continue this pattern throughout your practice session. When you are finish there should be a square patch with no to very little turf inside. The next person to use the teeing area should start from the back or side of the previous user's square. In time, you will be able to hit a pyramid of balls and only creating a divot area of about 1 square foot. For a preround warm up, the divot area should be smaller. Remember it is cool to be square when hitting on the range tee.
